
To The Reader:

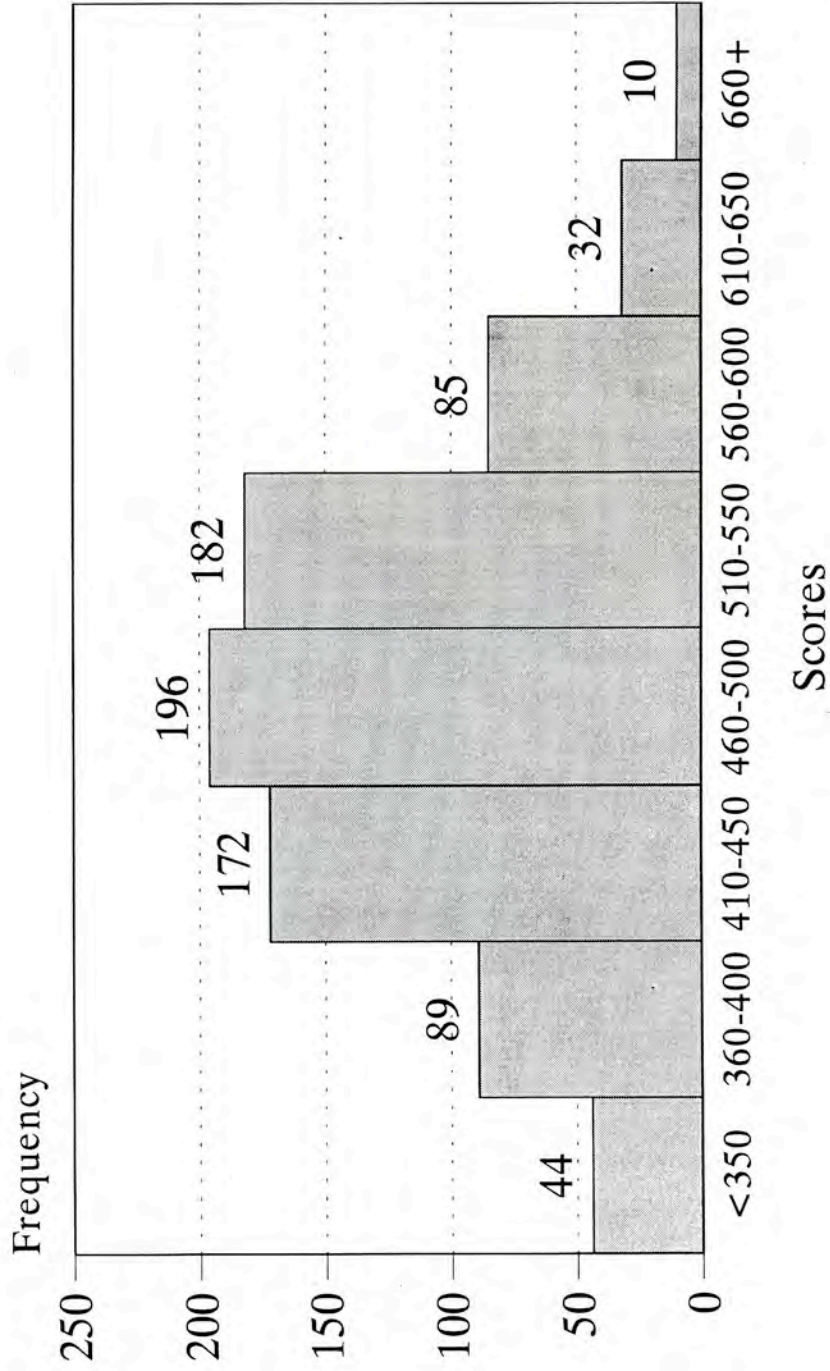

Bridgewater State College



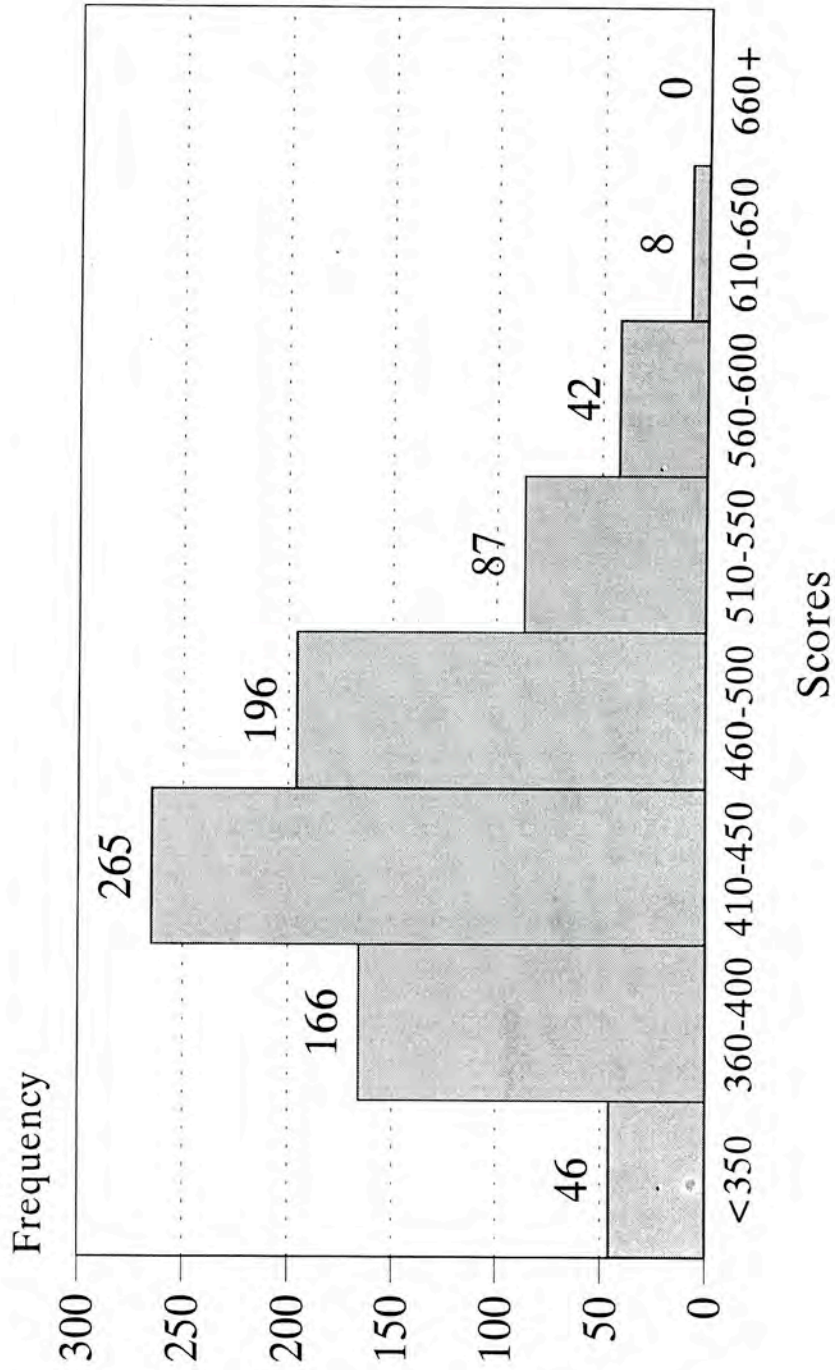

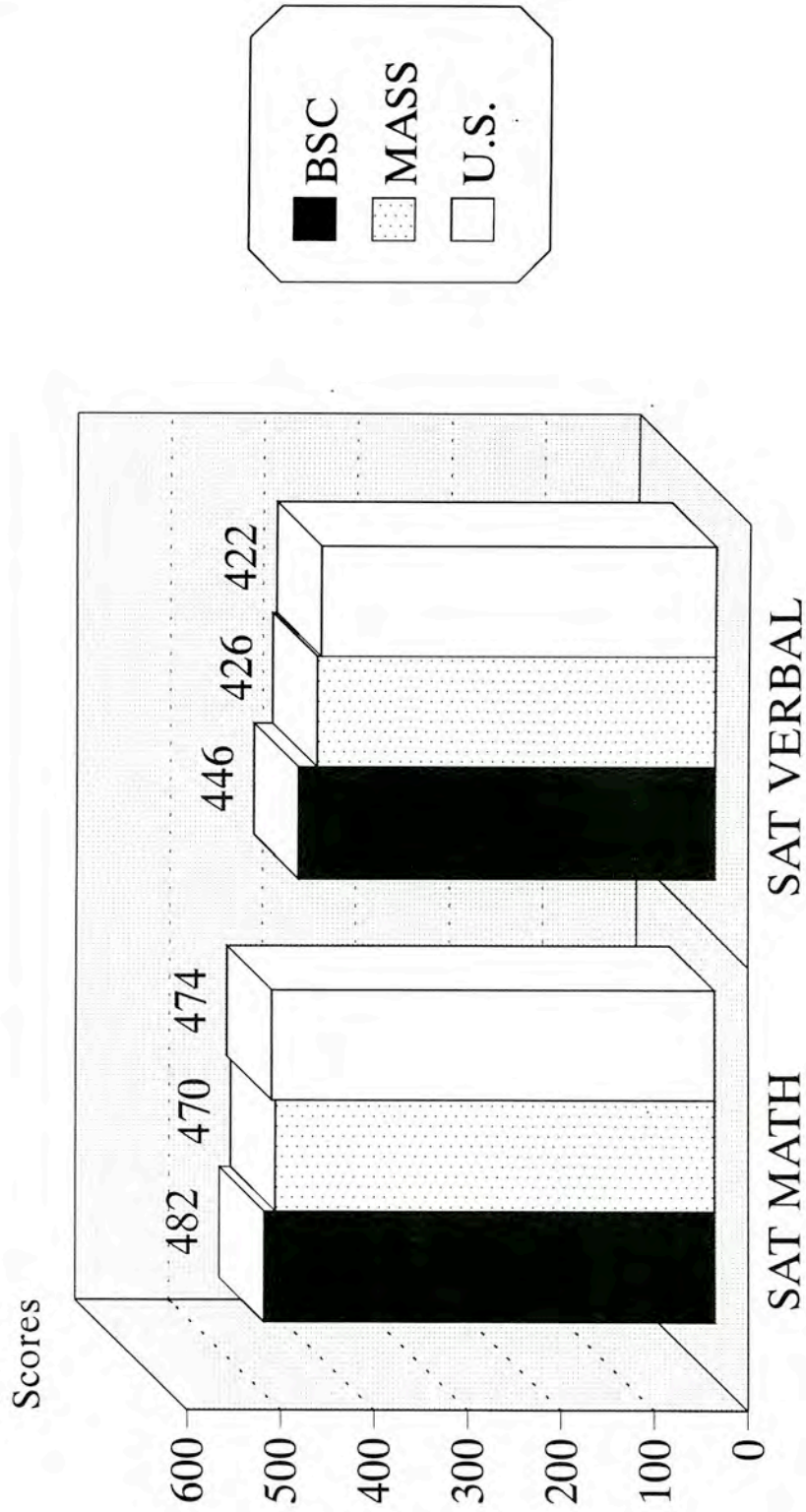

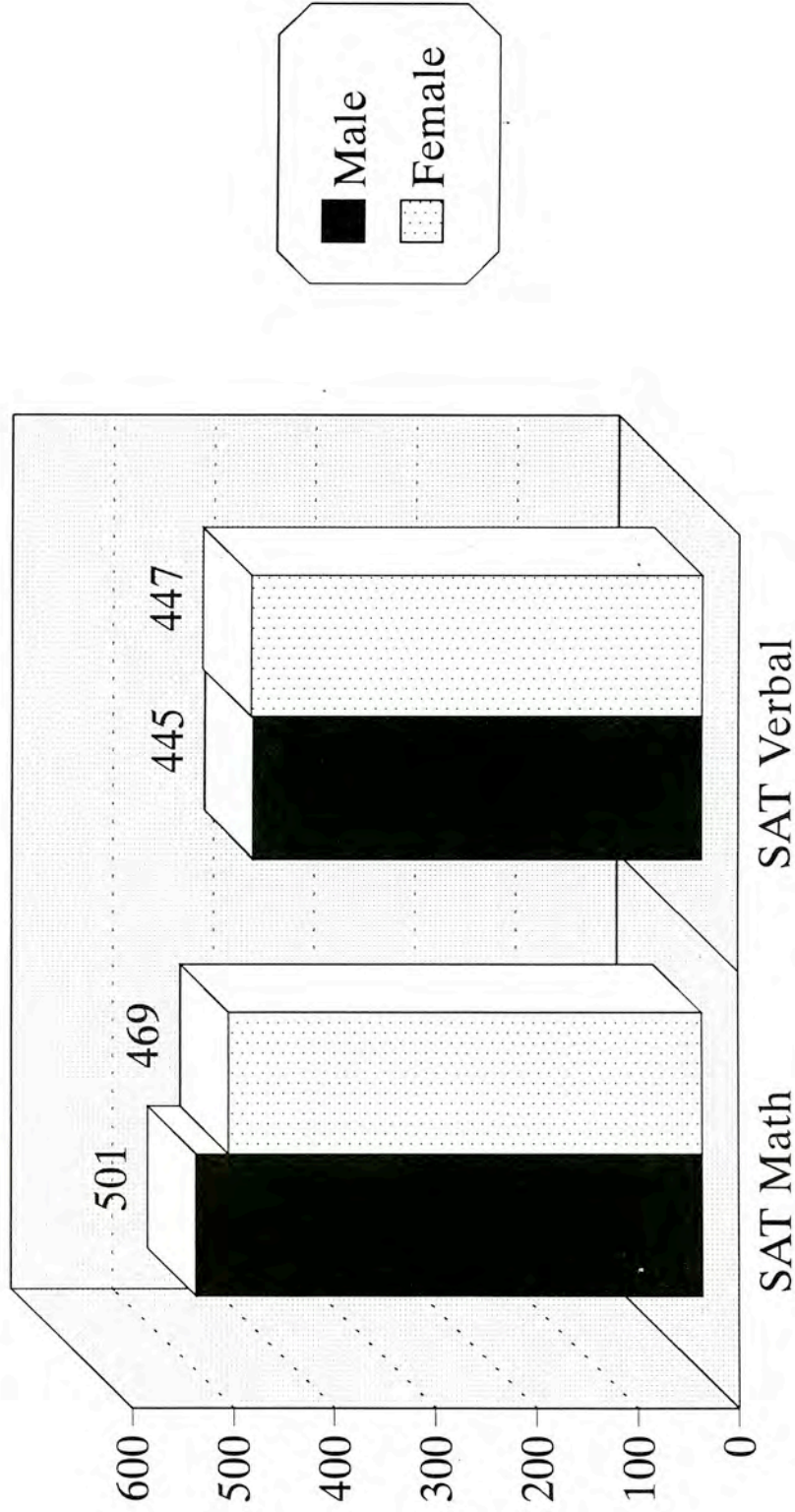

Average SAT Performance by Gender

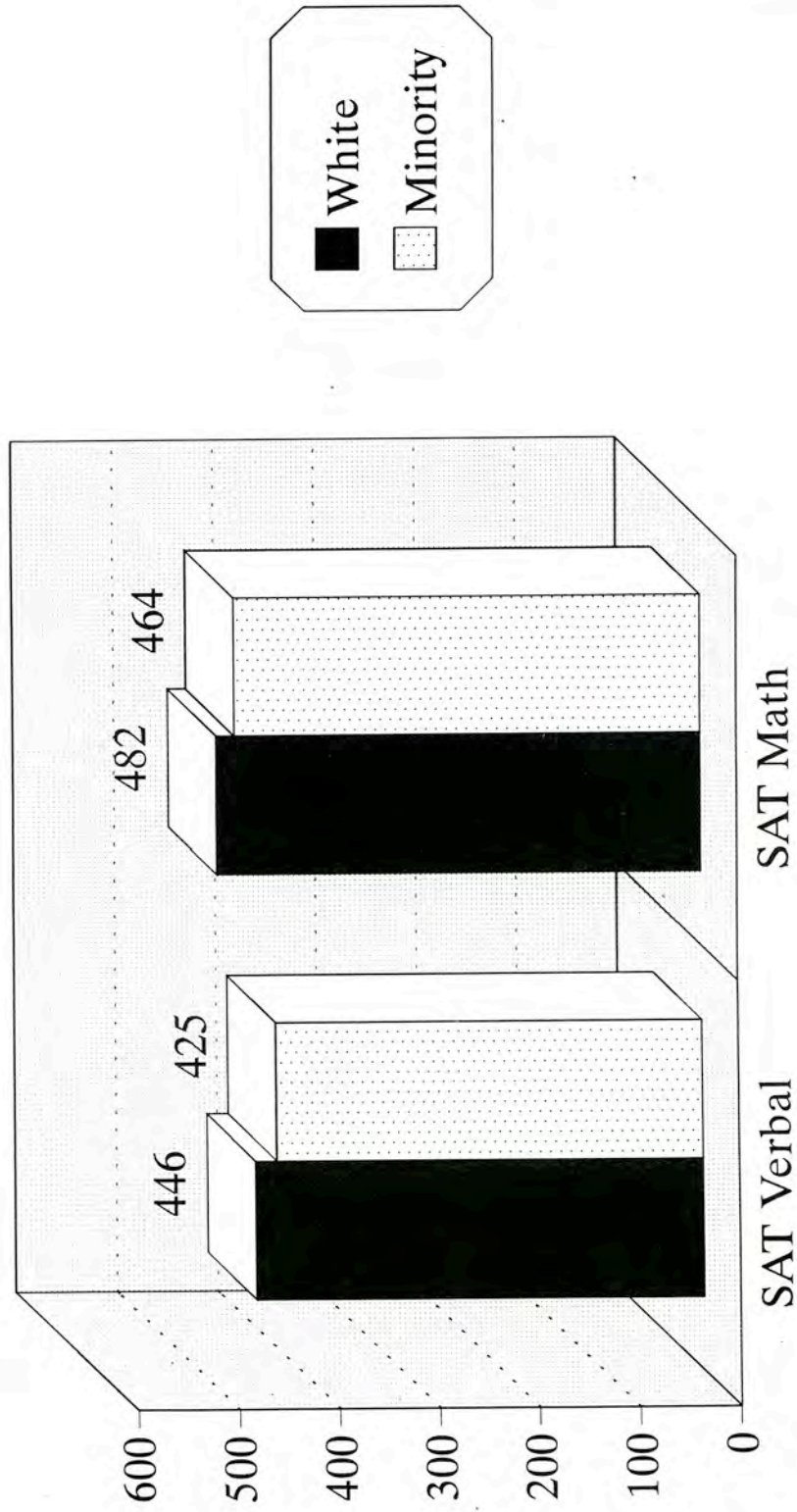

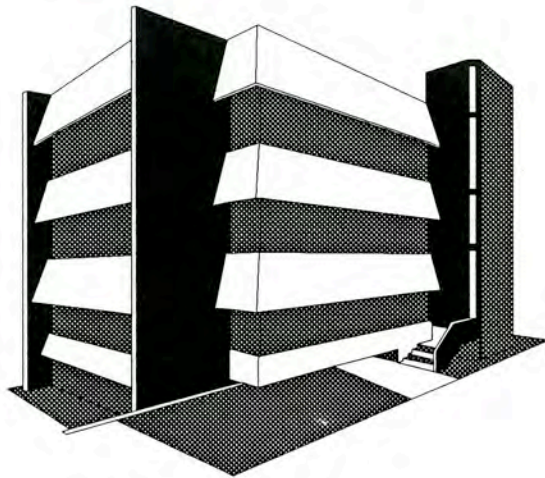

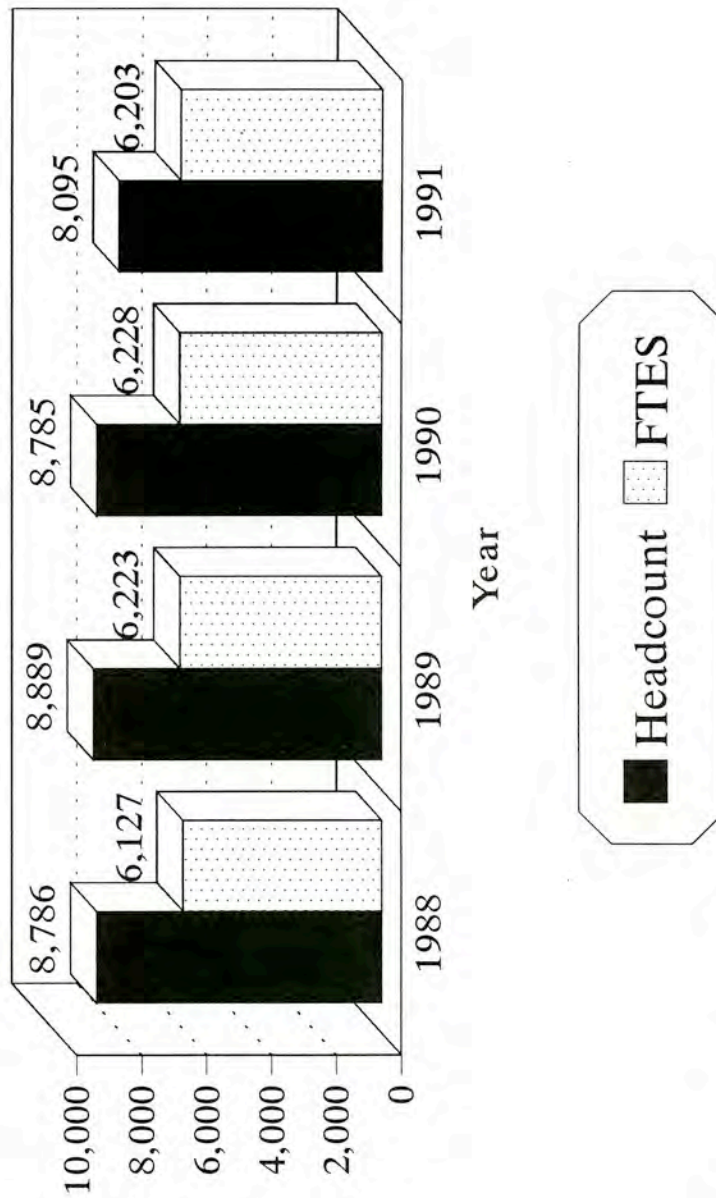
STUDENT ENROLLMENT

Total Enrollment

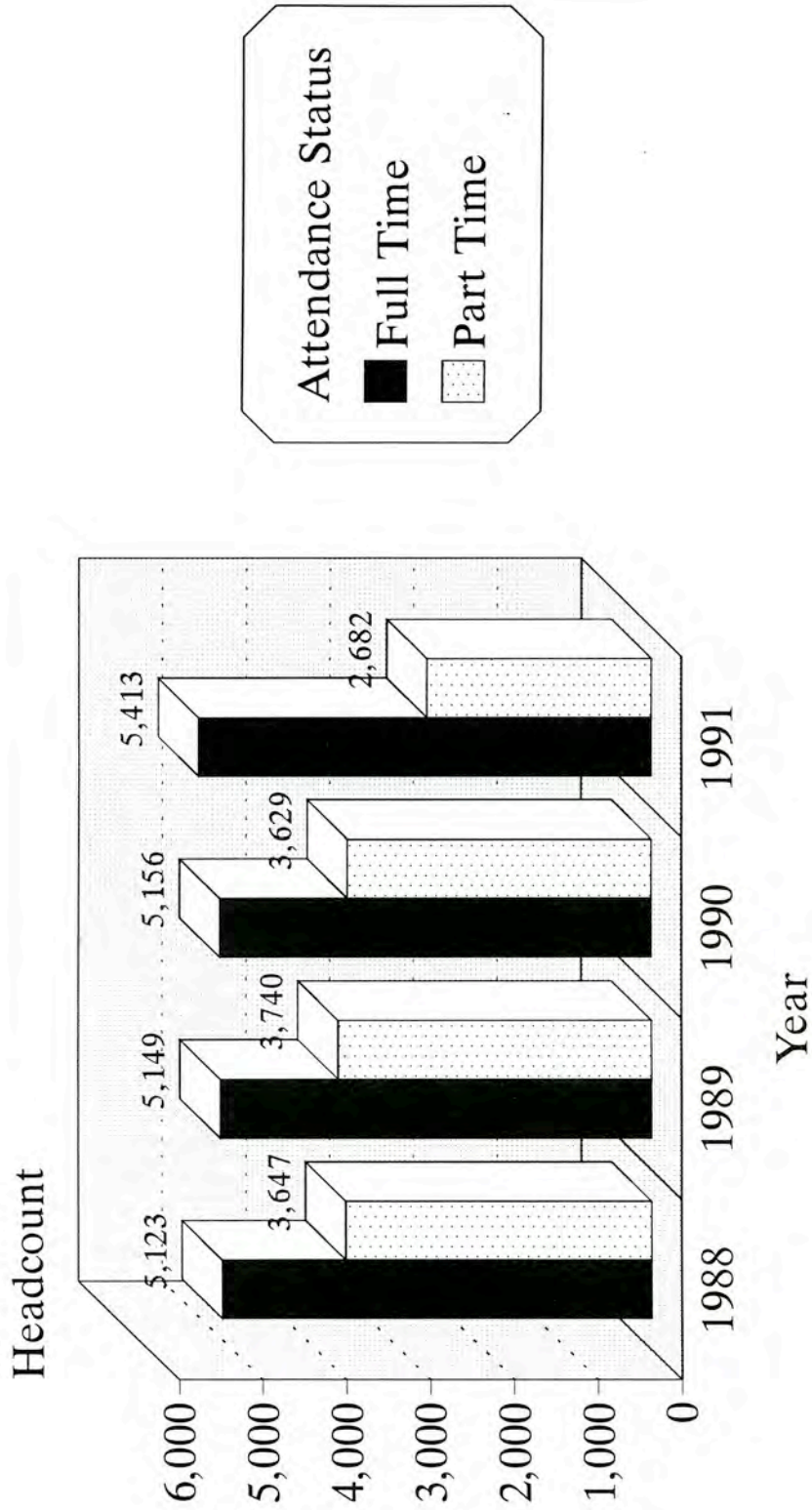

Total Enrollment by Attendance Status

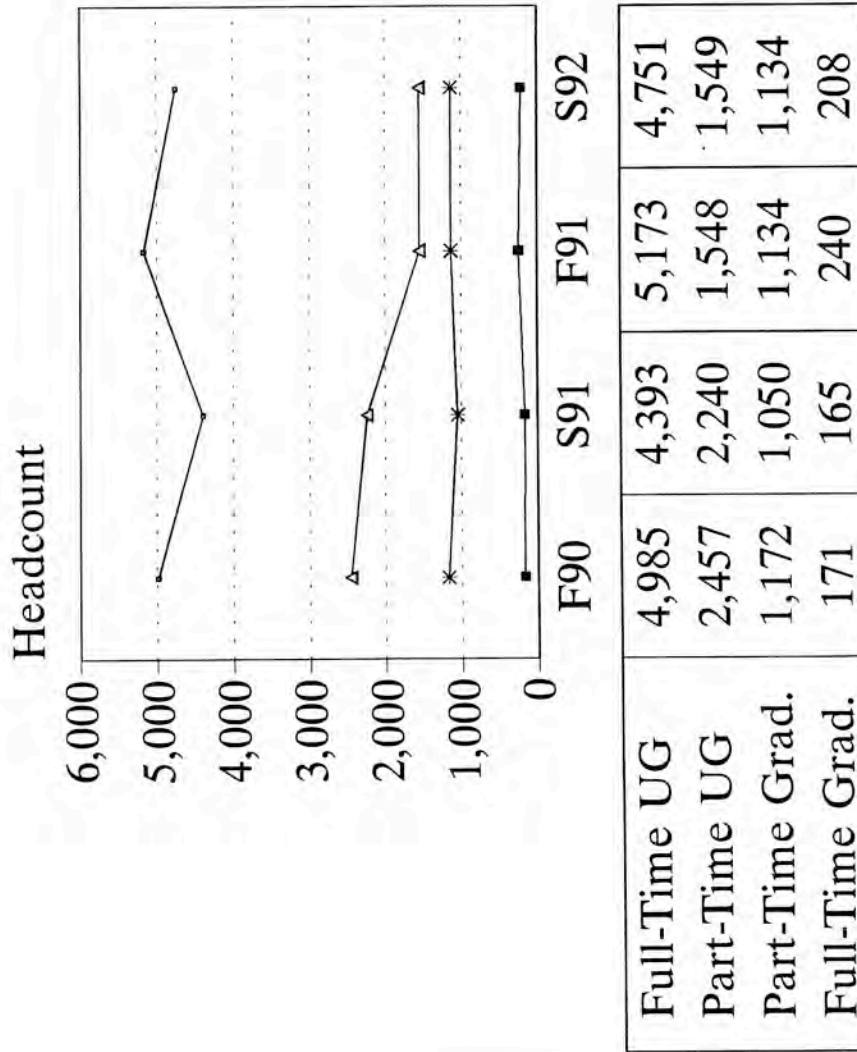

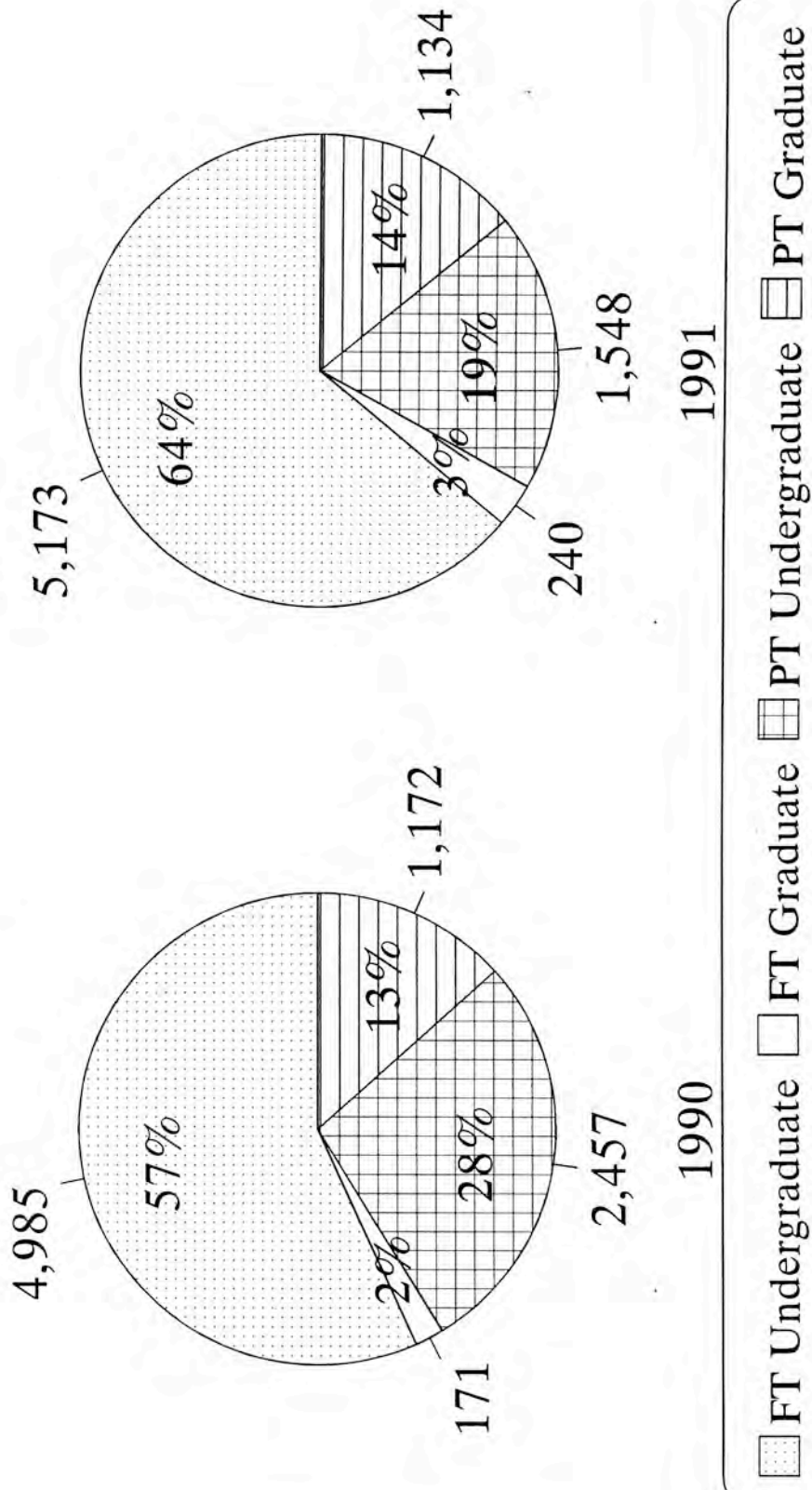

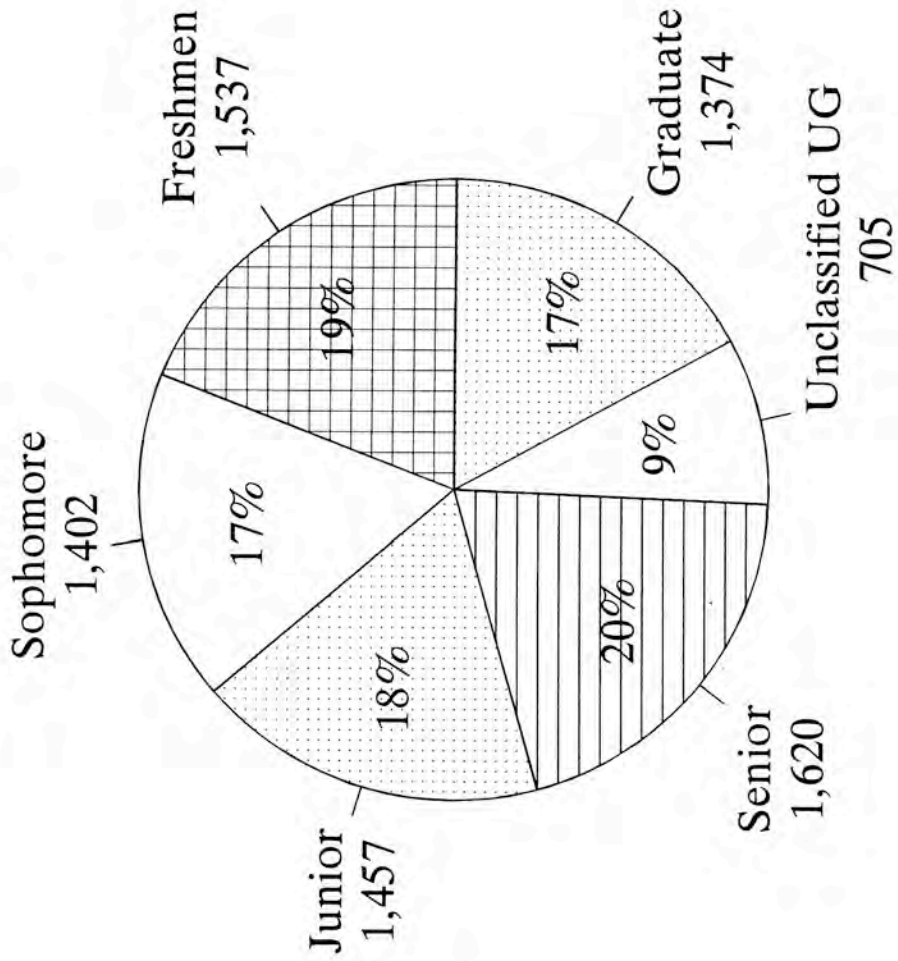

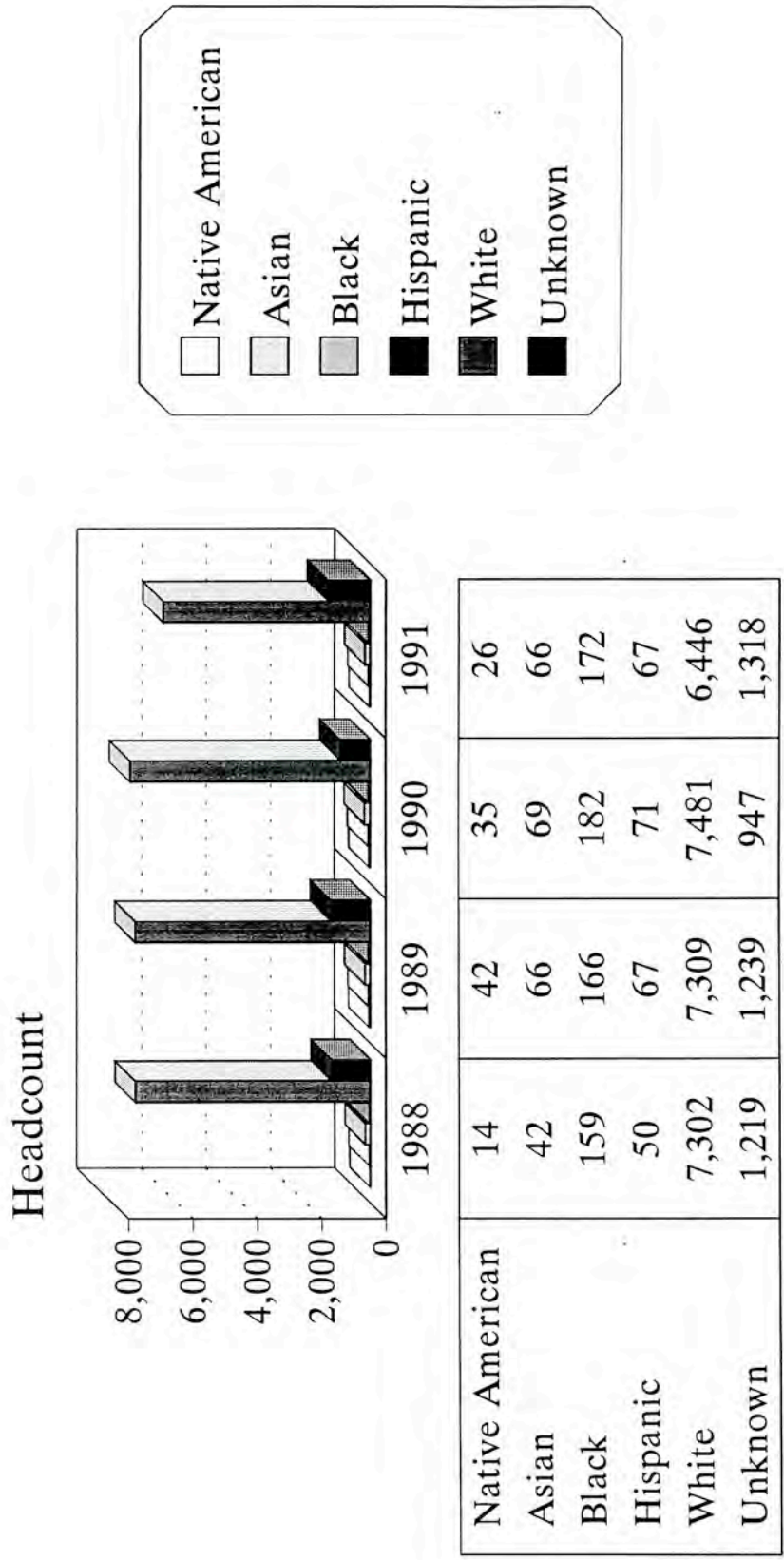

Total Enrollment by Race

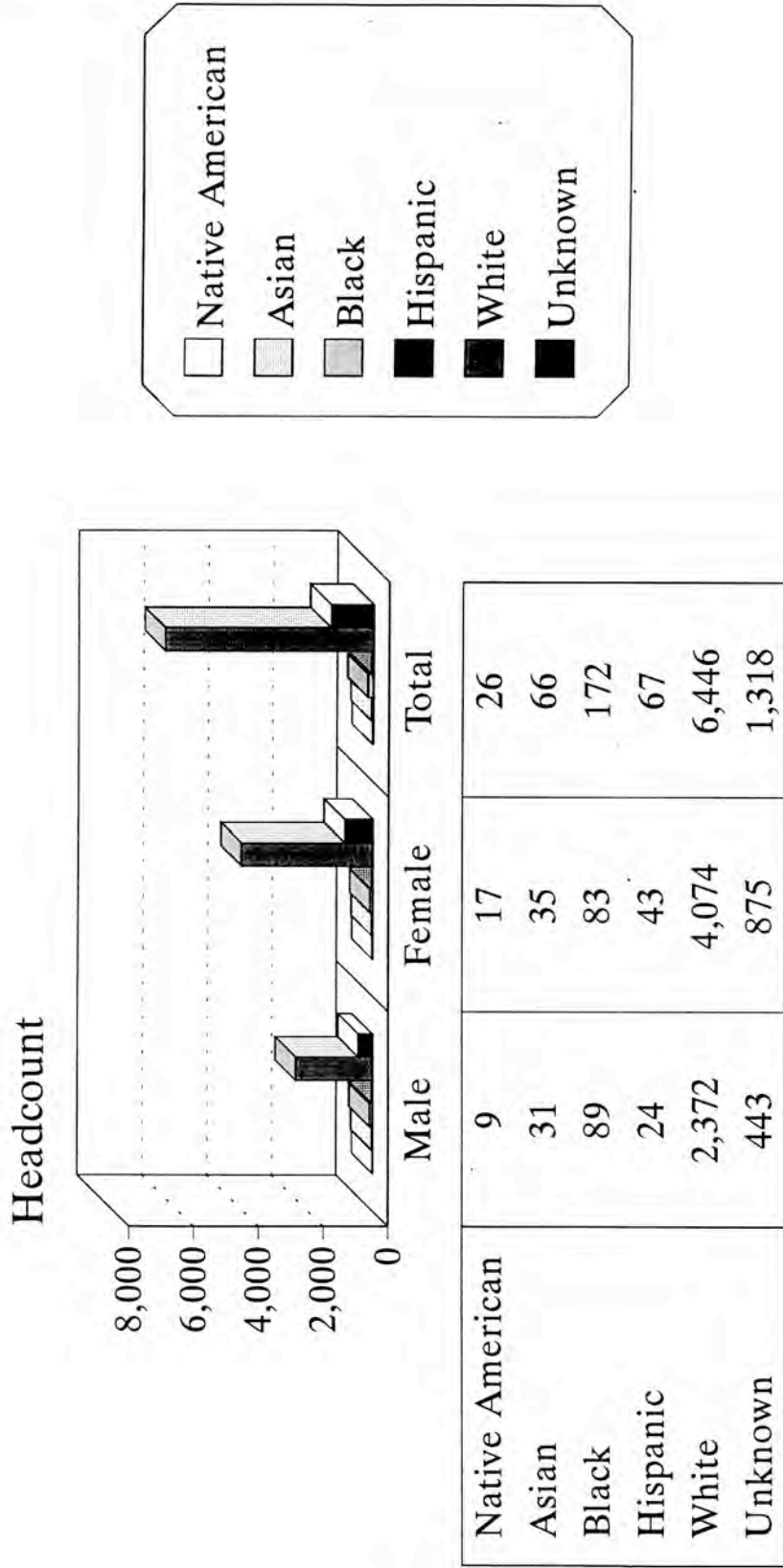

Total Enrollment by Race and Gender

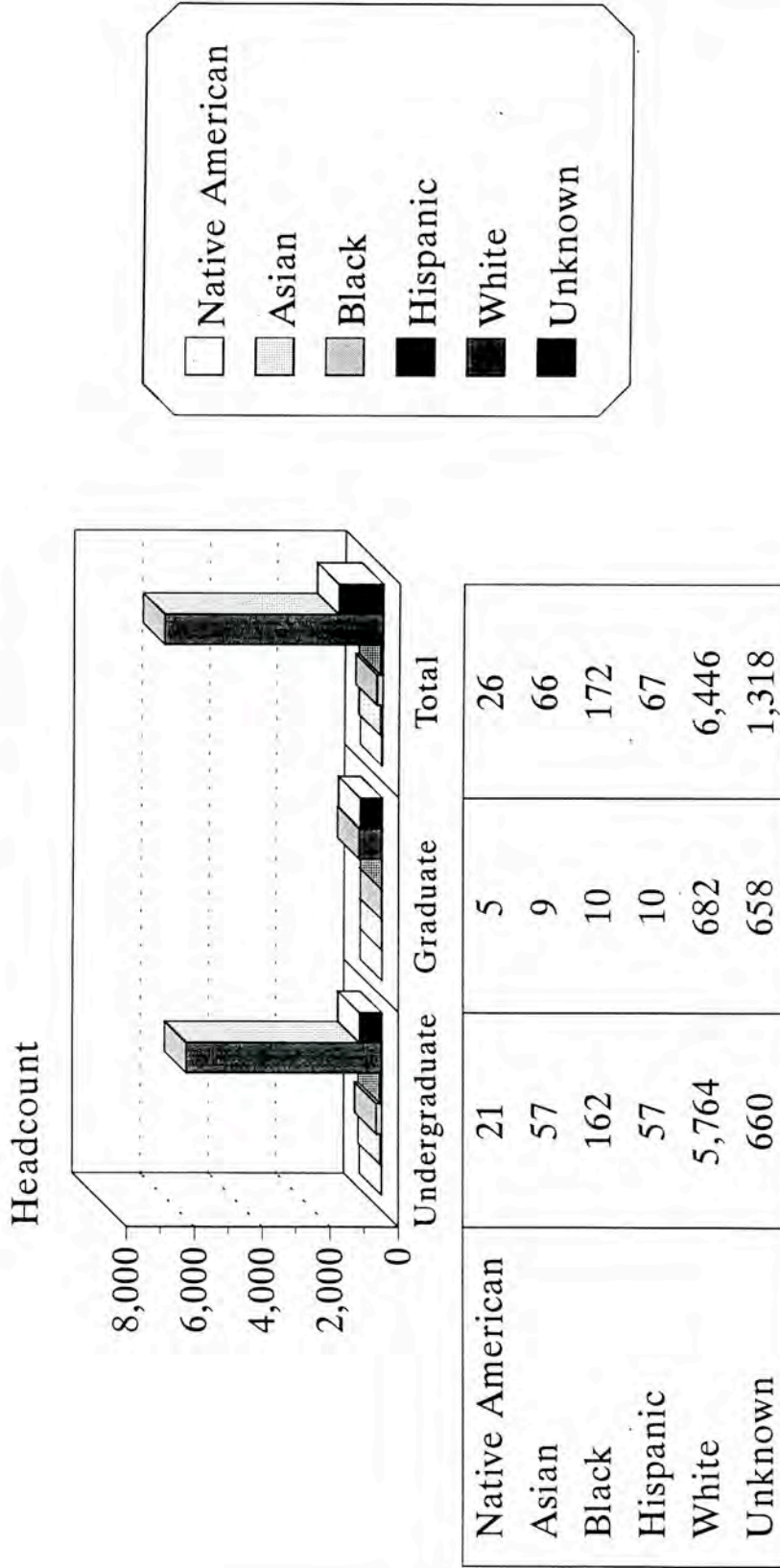

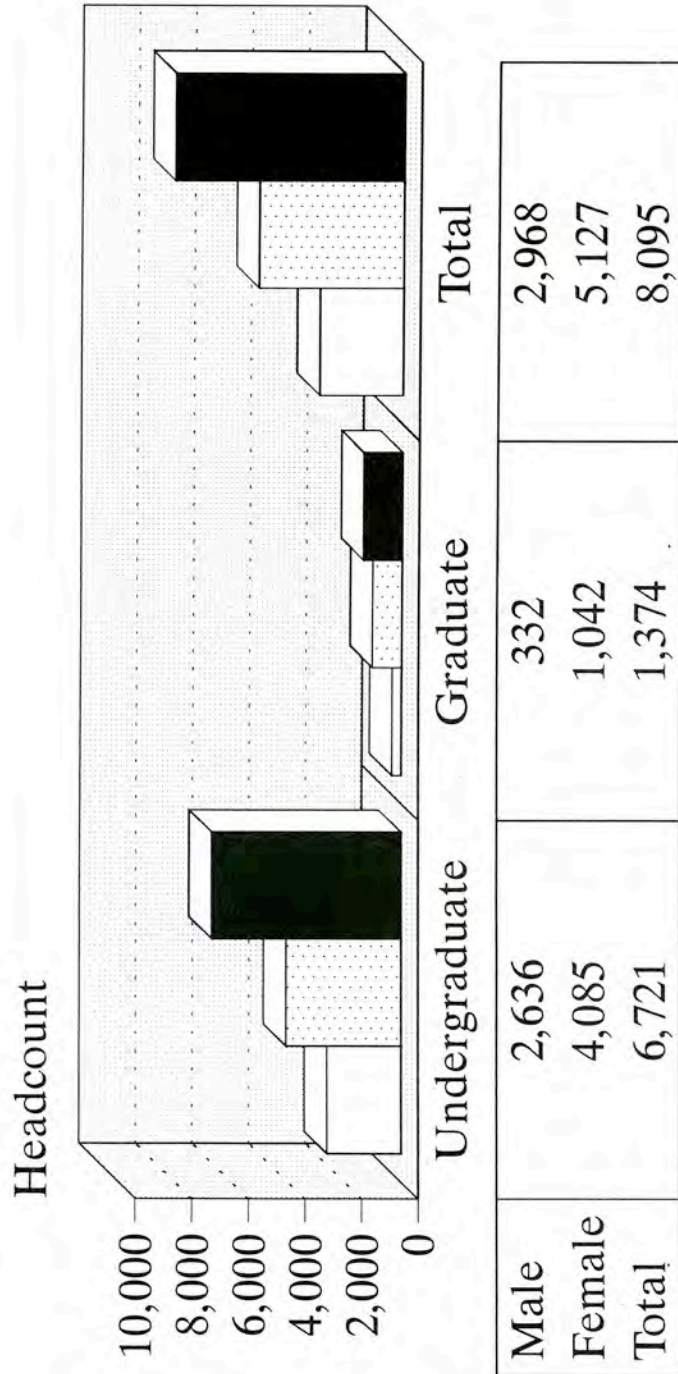

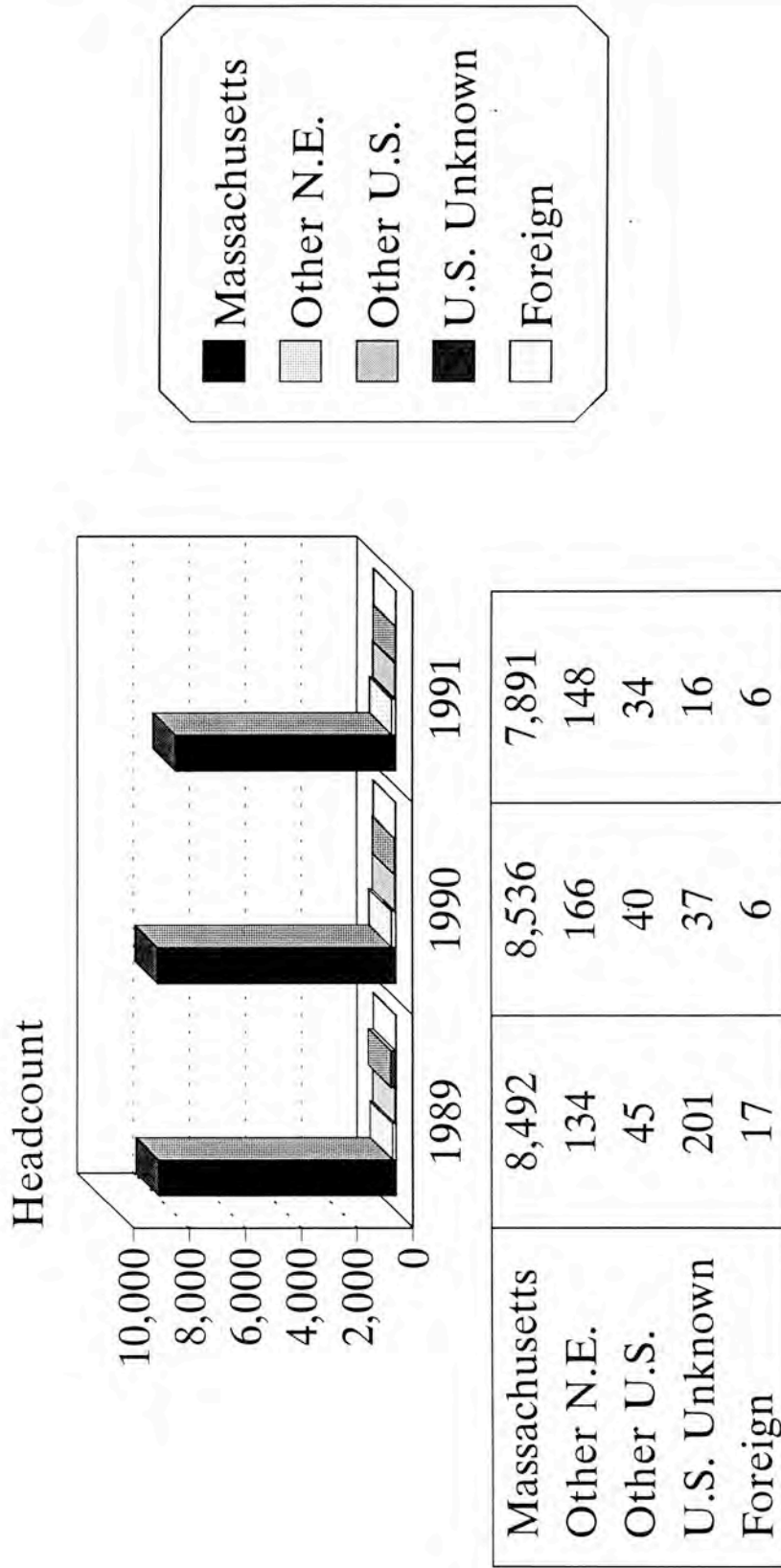

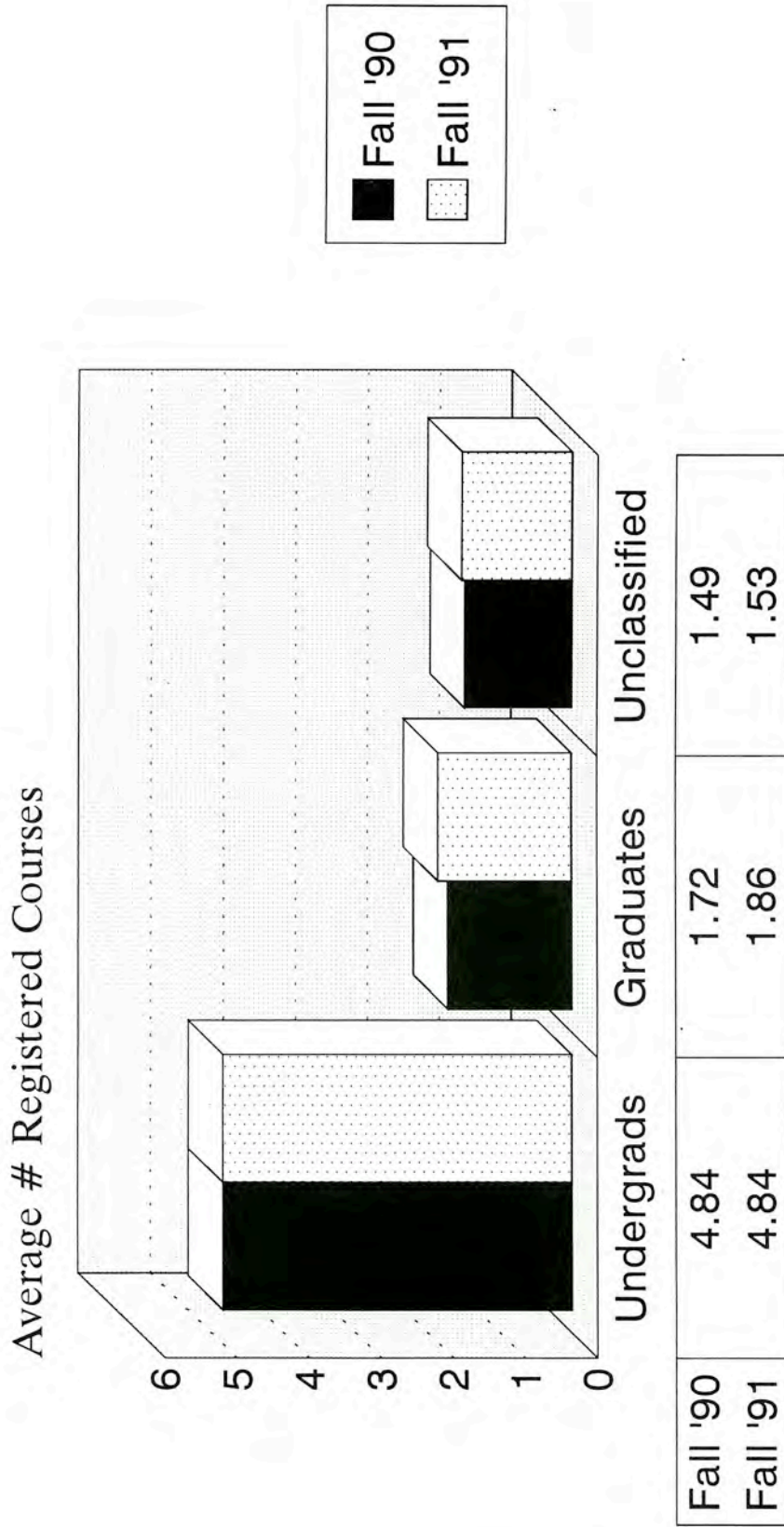

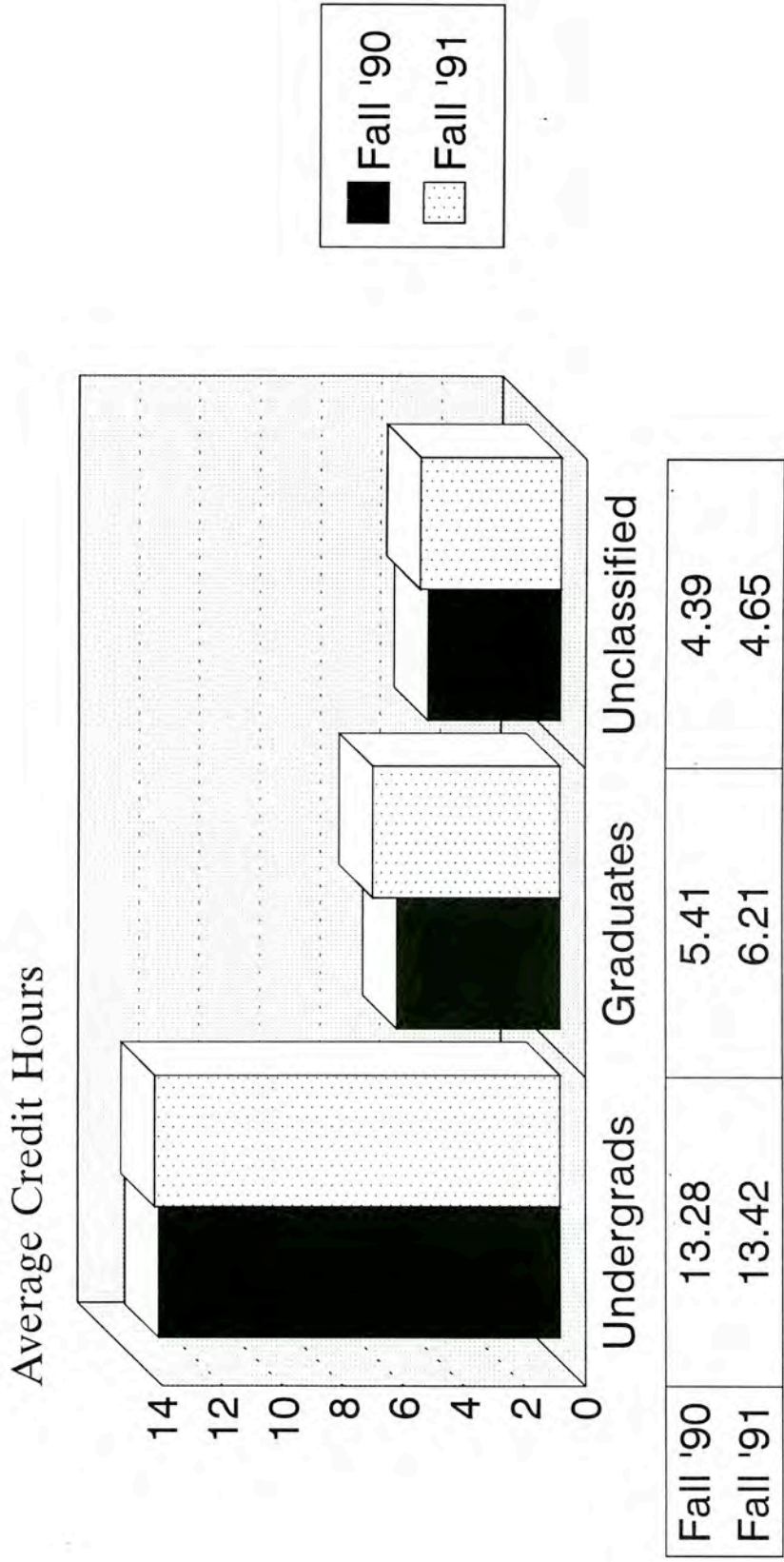

Degrees Awarded by Gender and Program Level

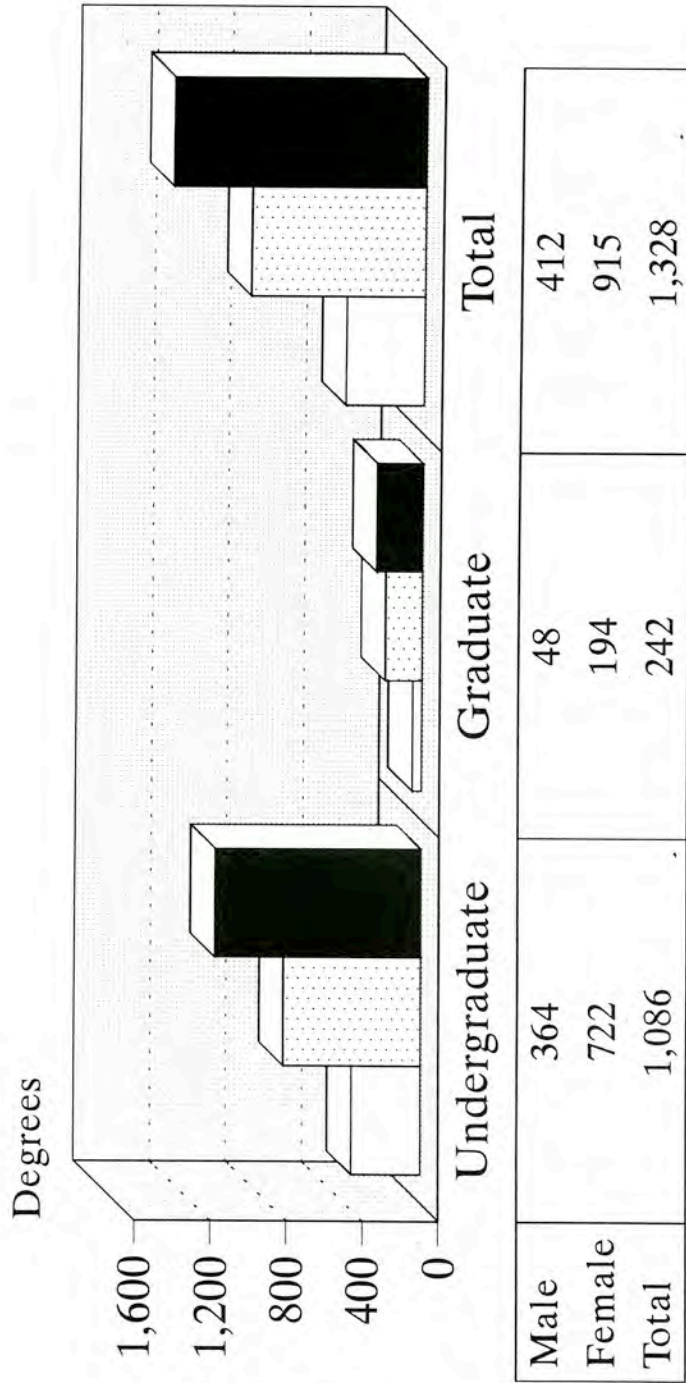

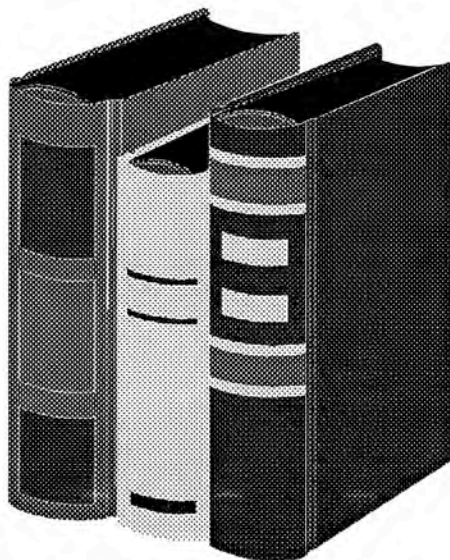

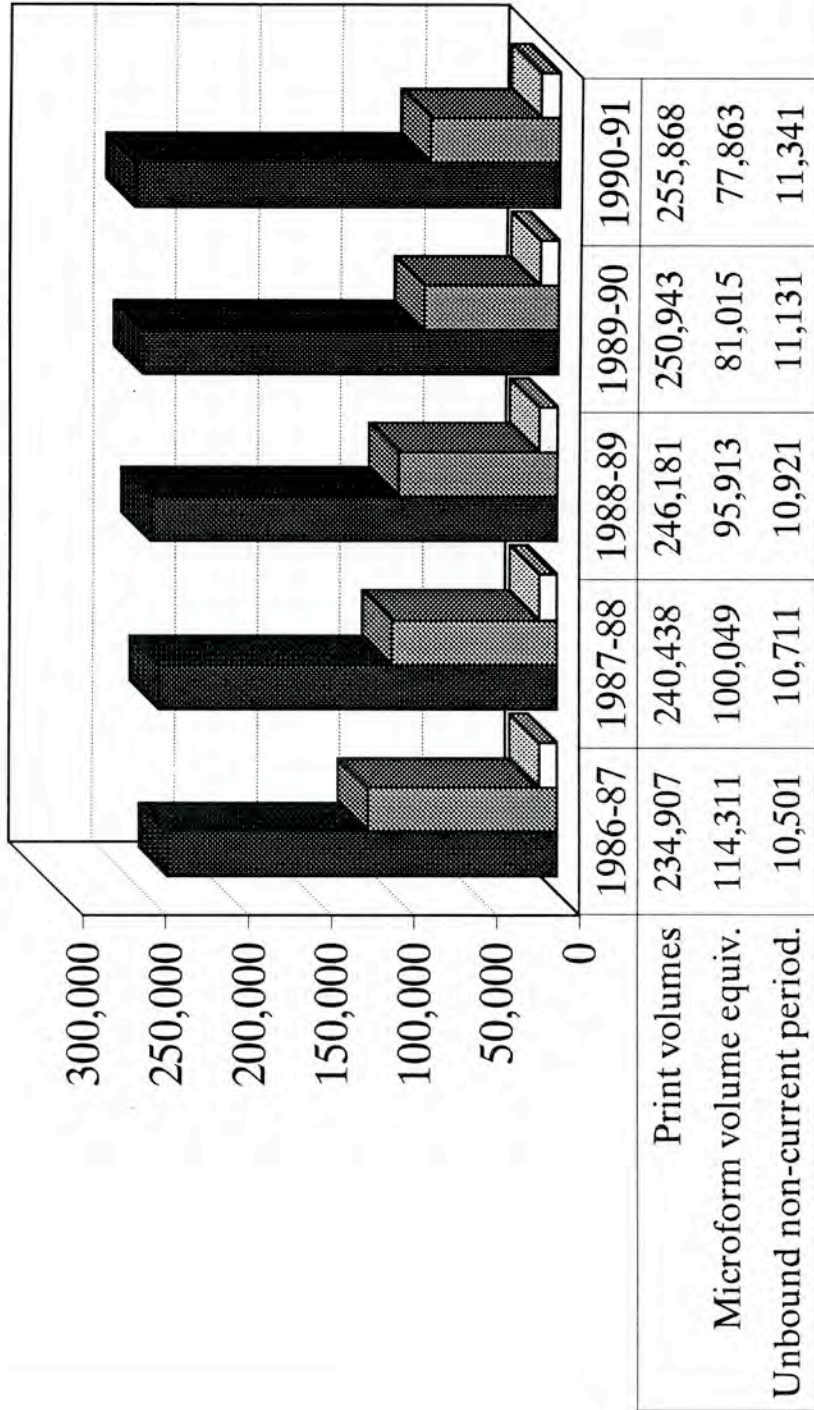

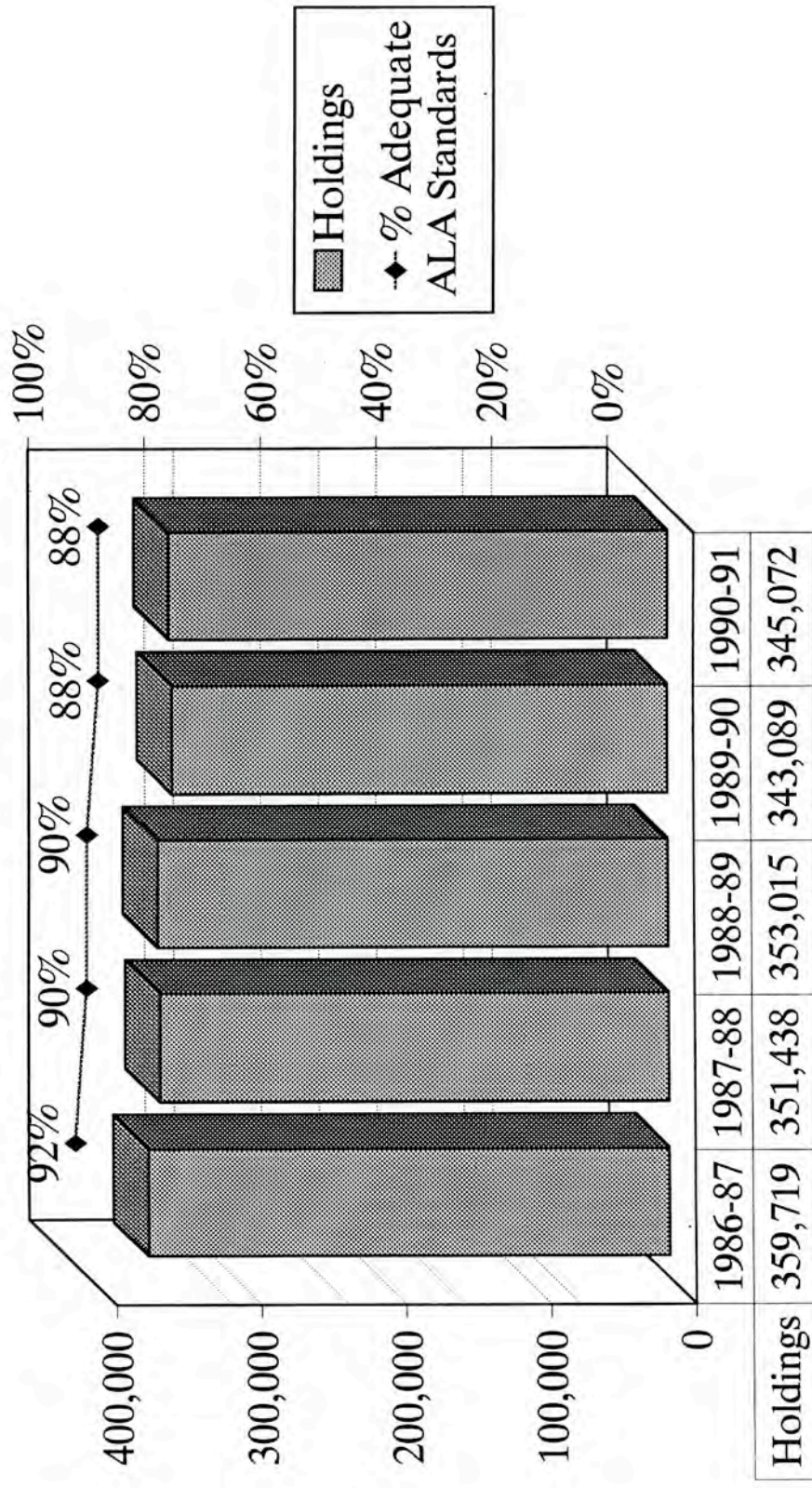

TOTAL MAXWELL LIBRARY HOLDINGS & ADEQUACY BY YEAR

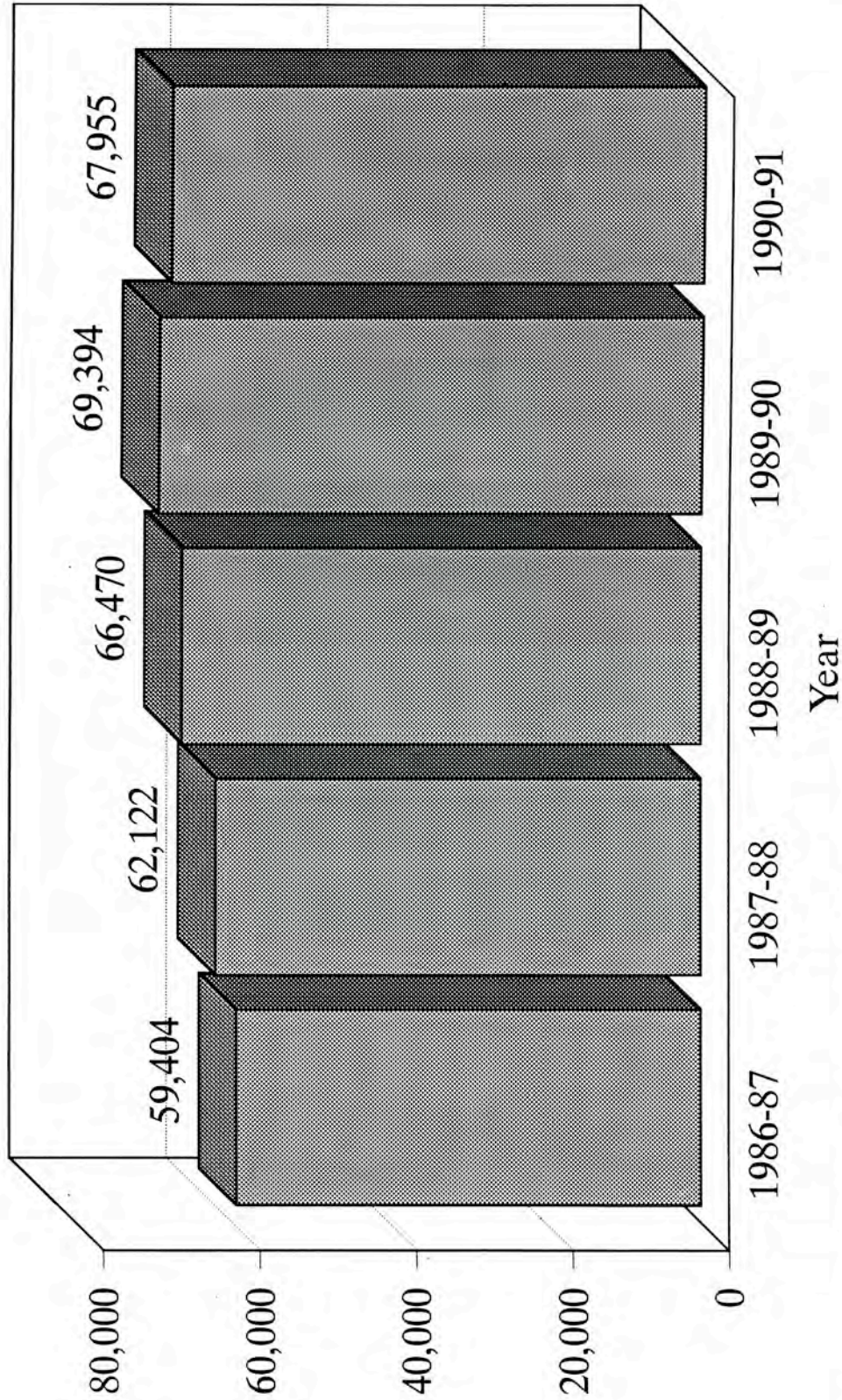

TOTAL NUMBER OF VOLUMES LOANED FROM MAXWELL LIBRARY BY YEAR

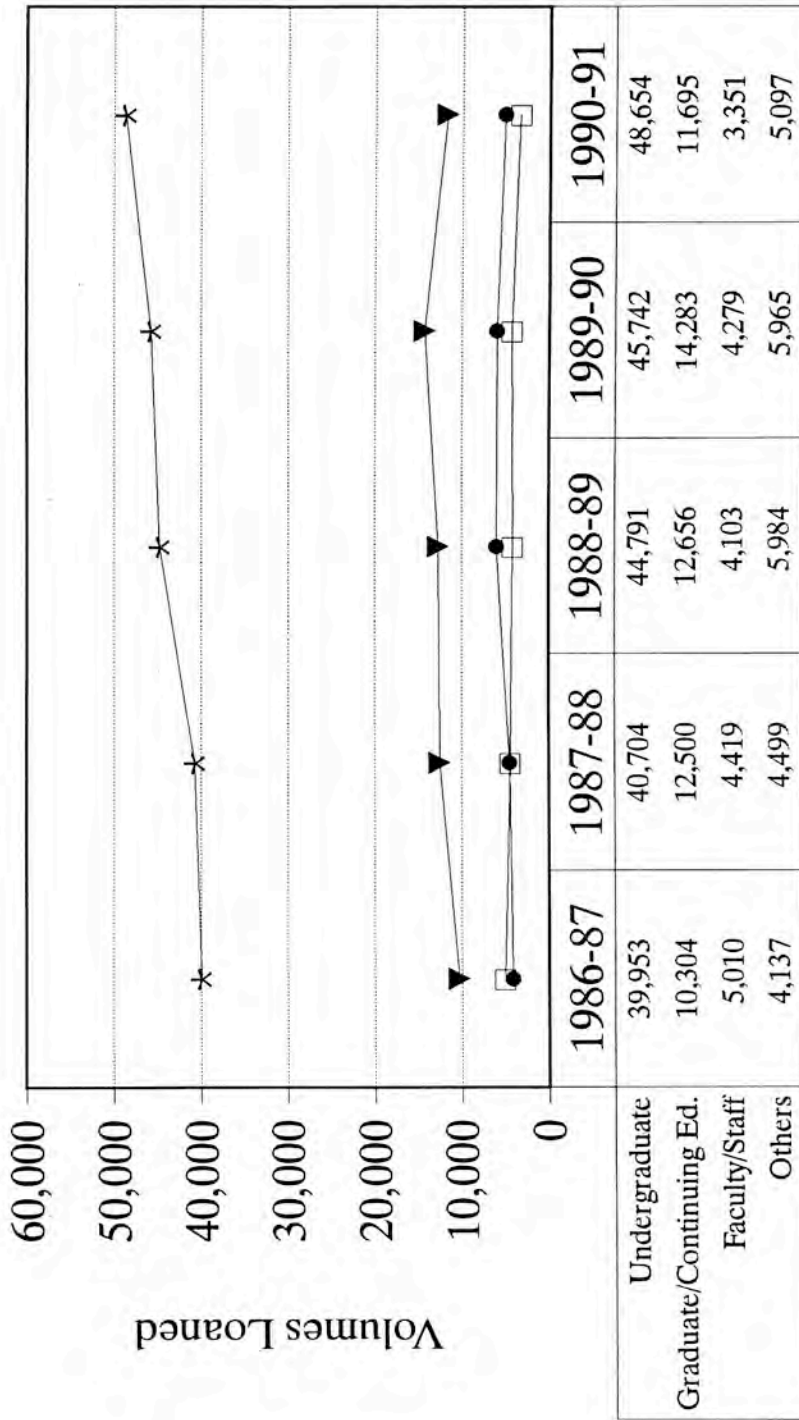

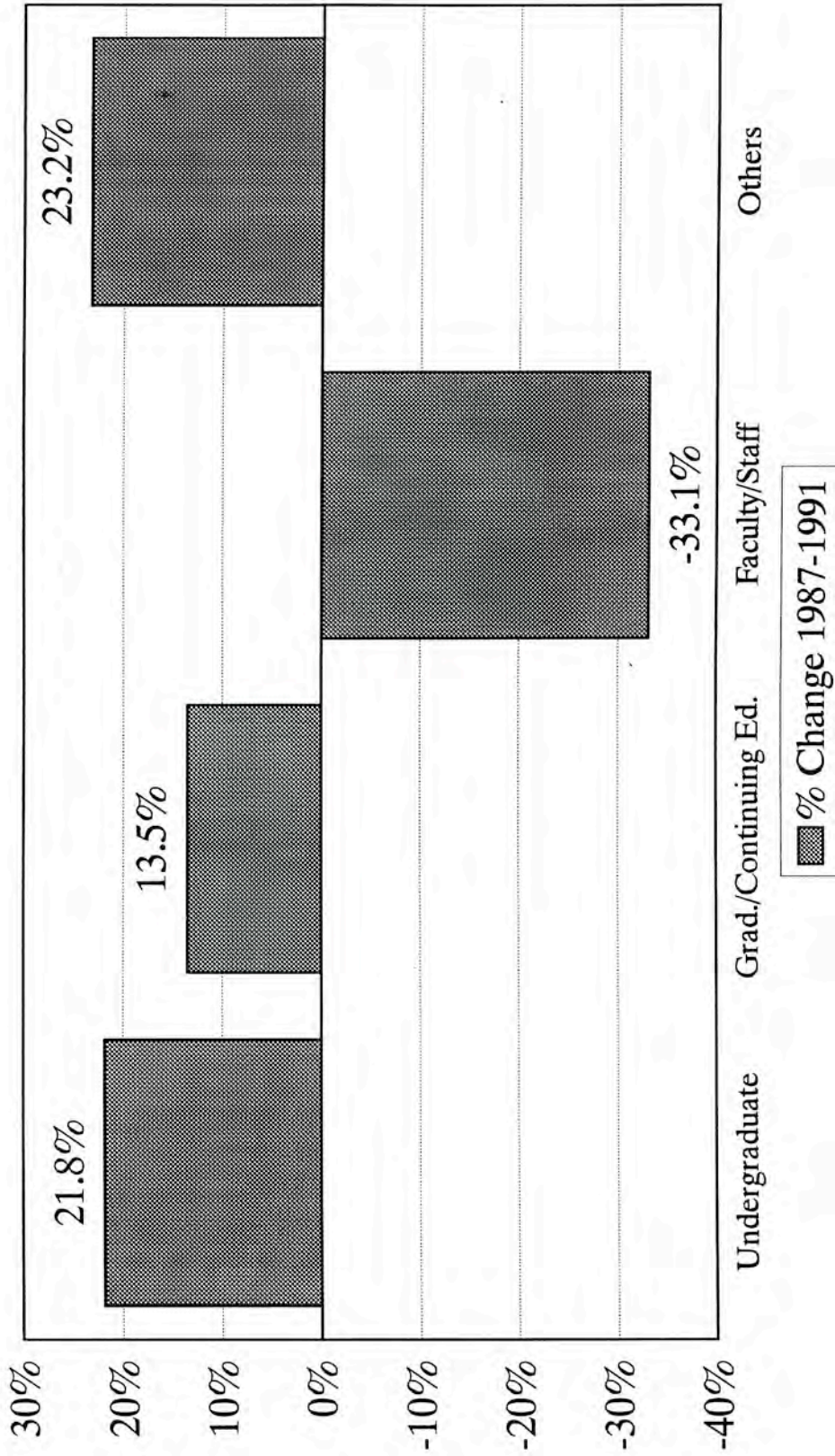

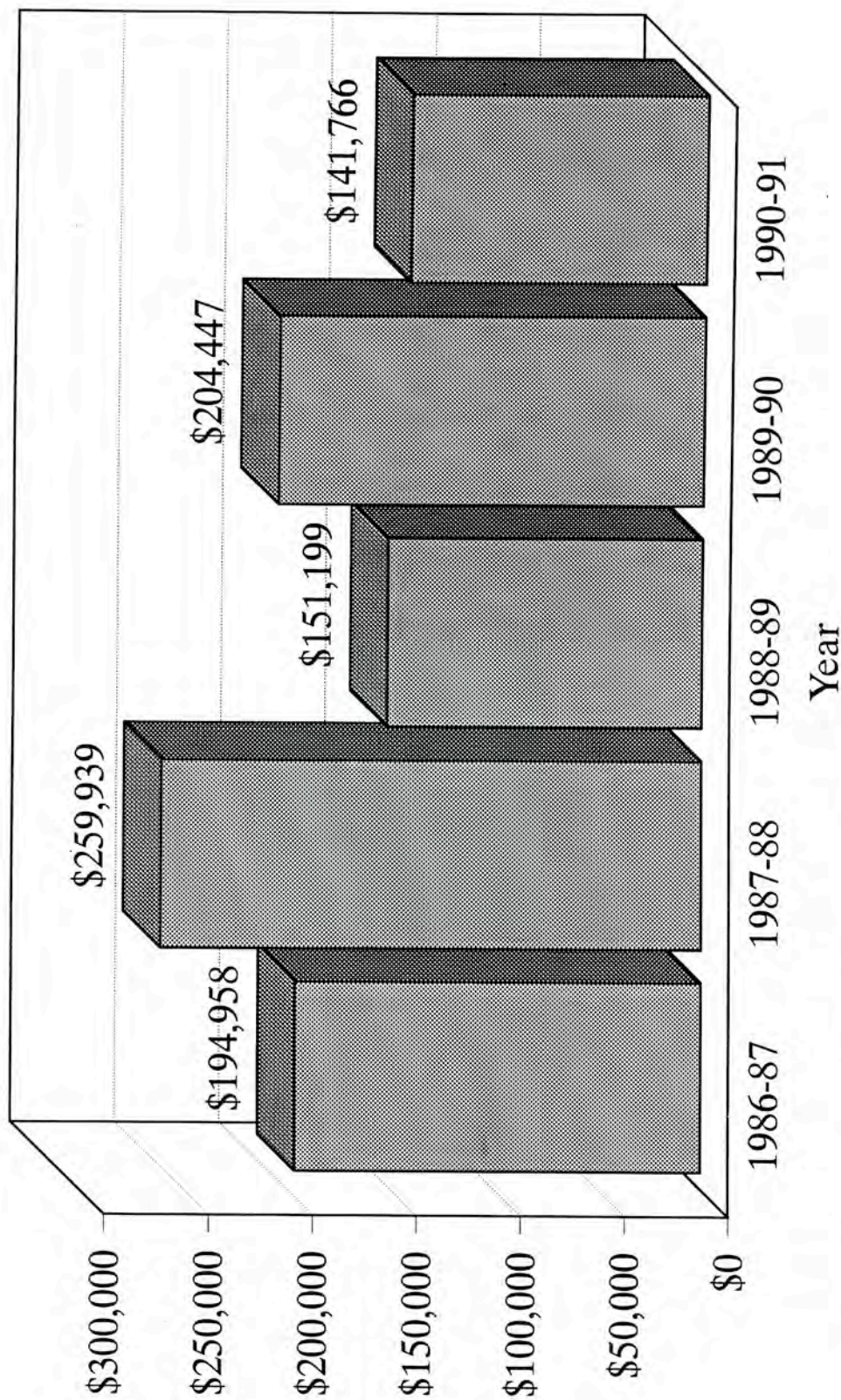

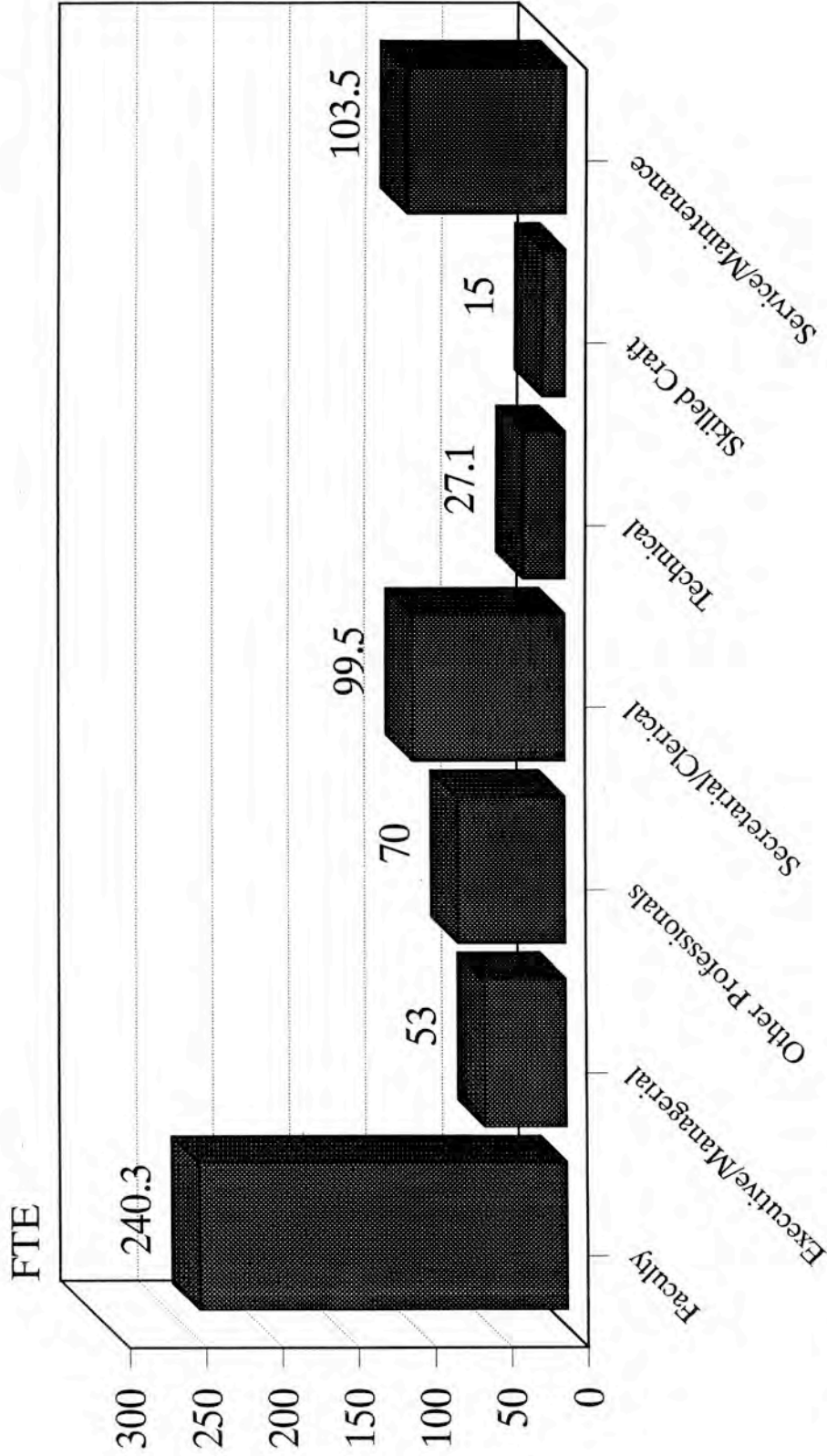

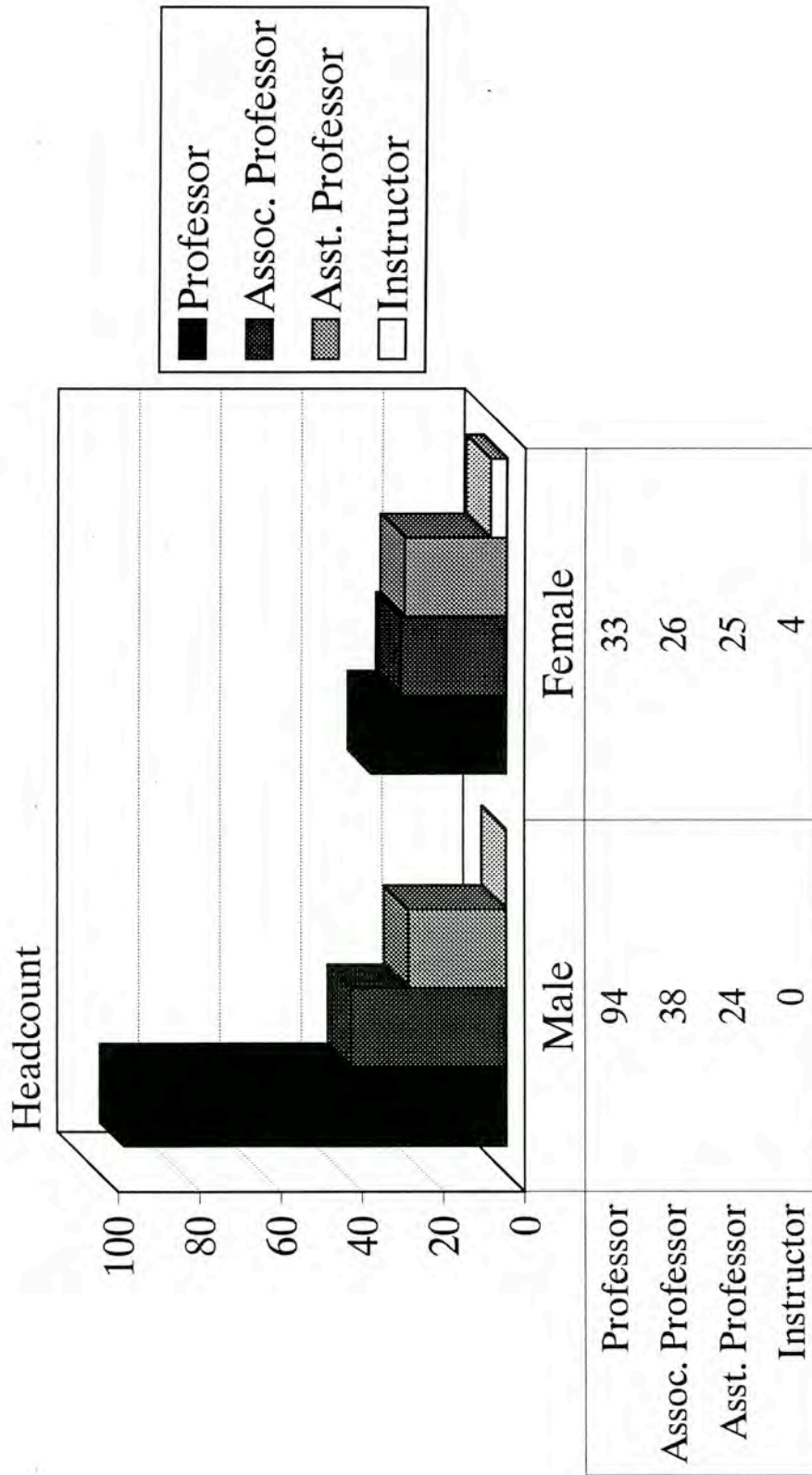

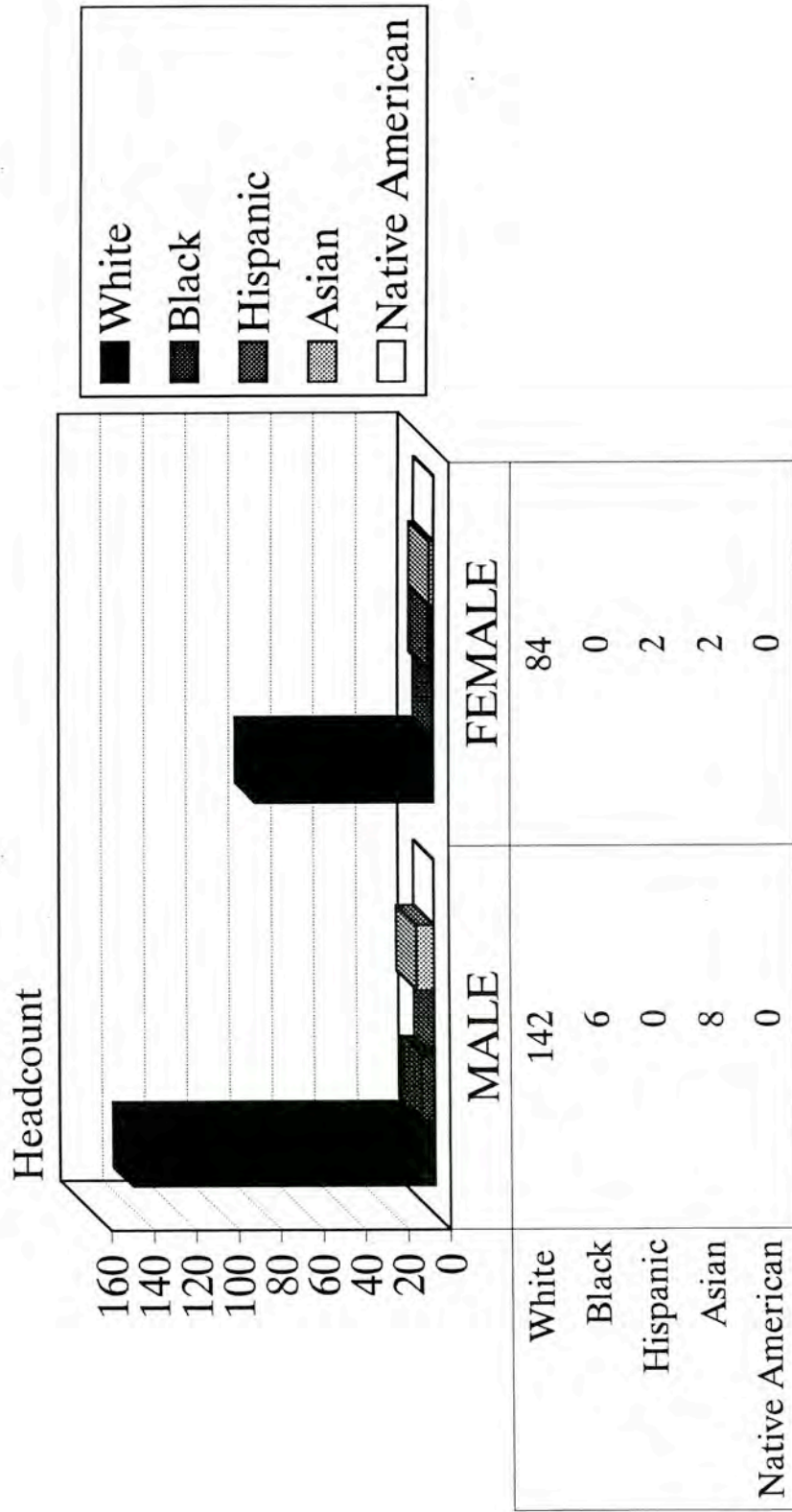

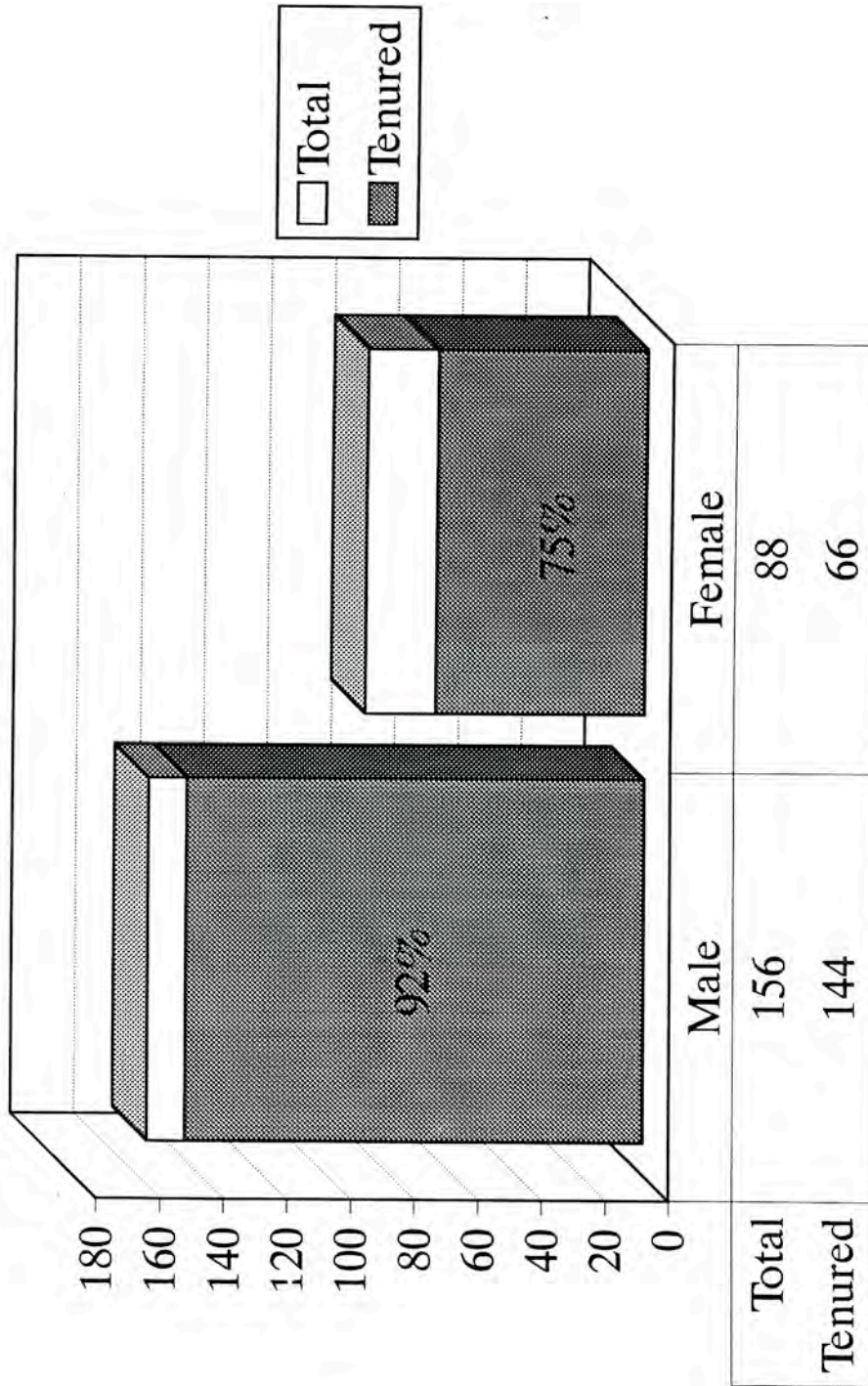

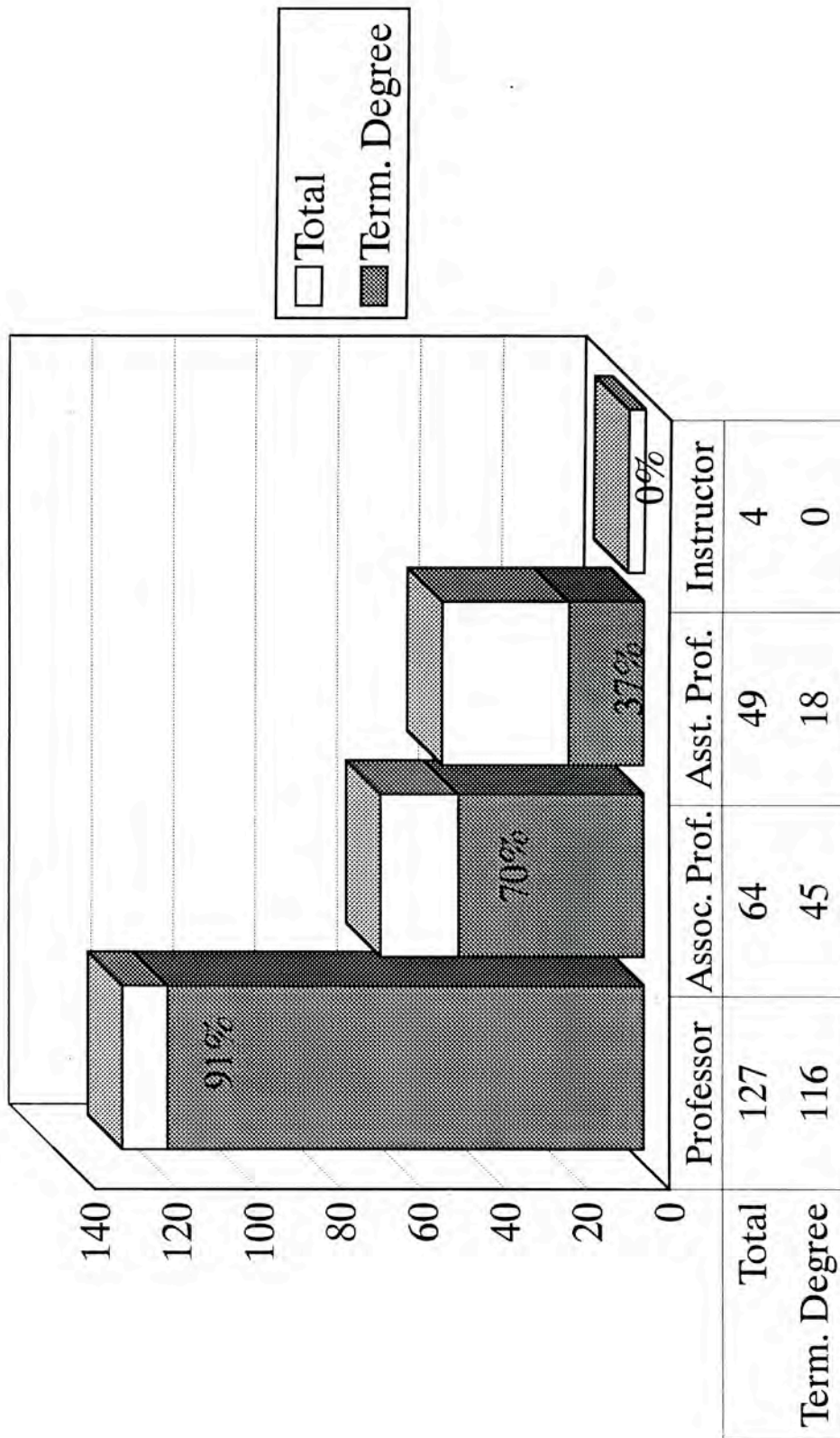

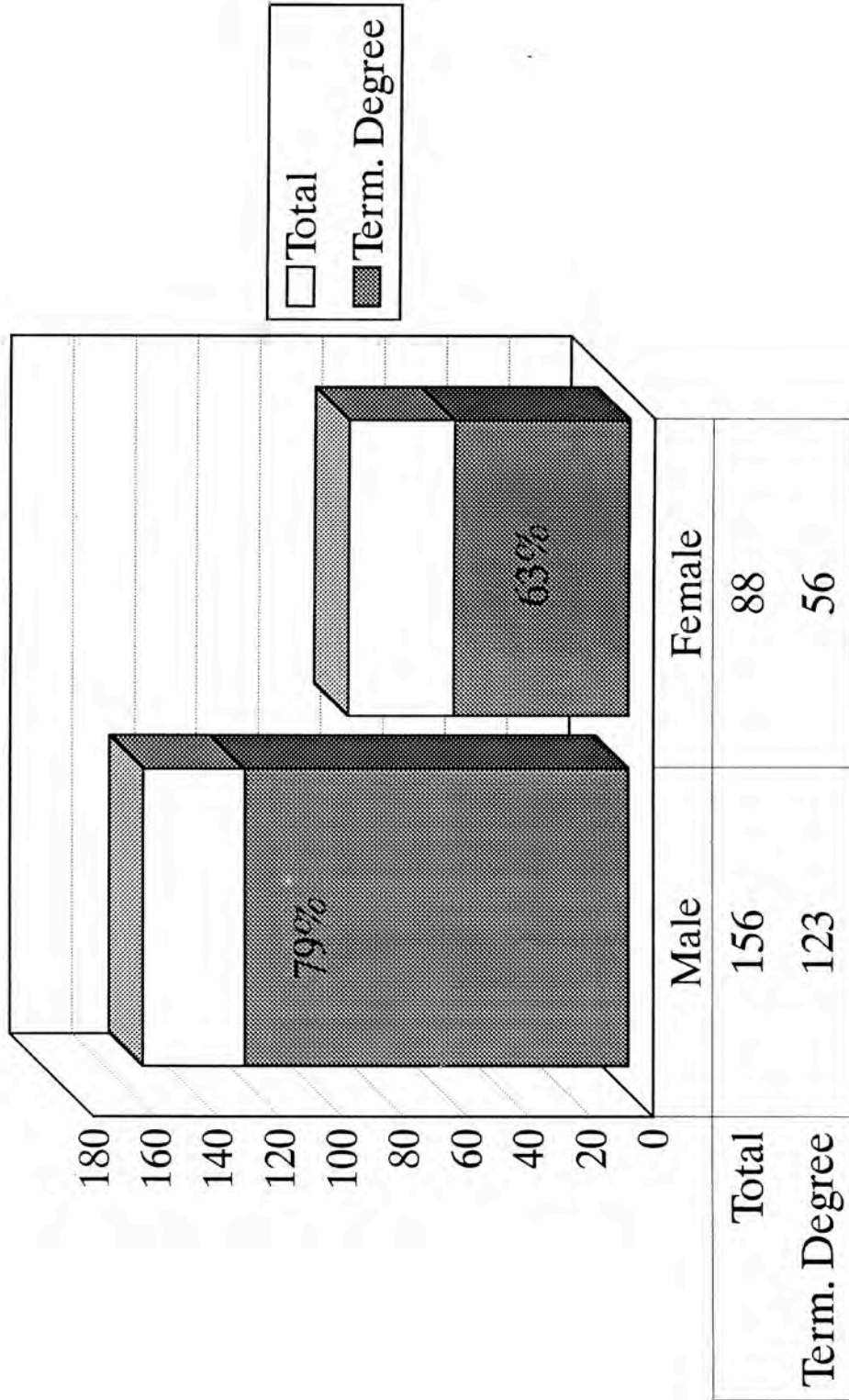

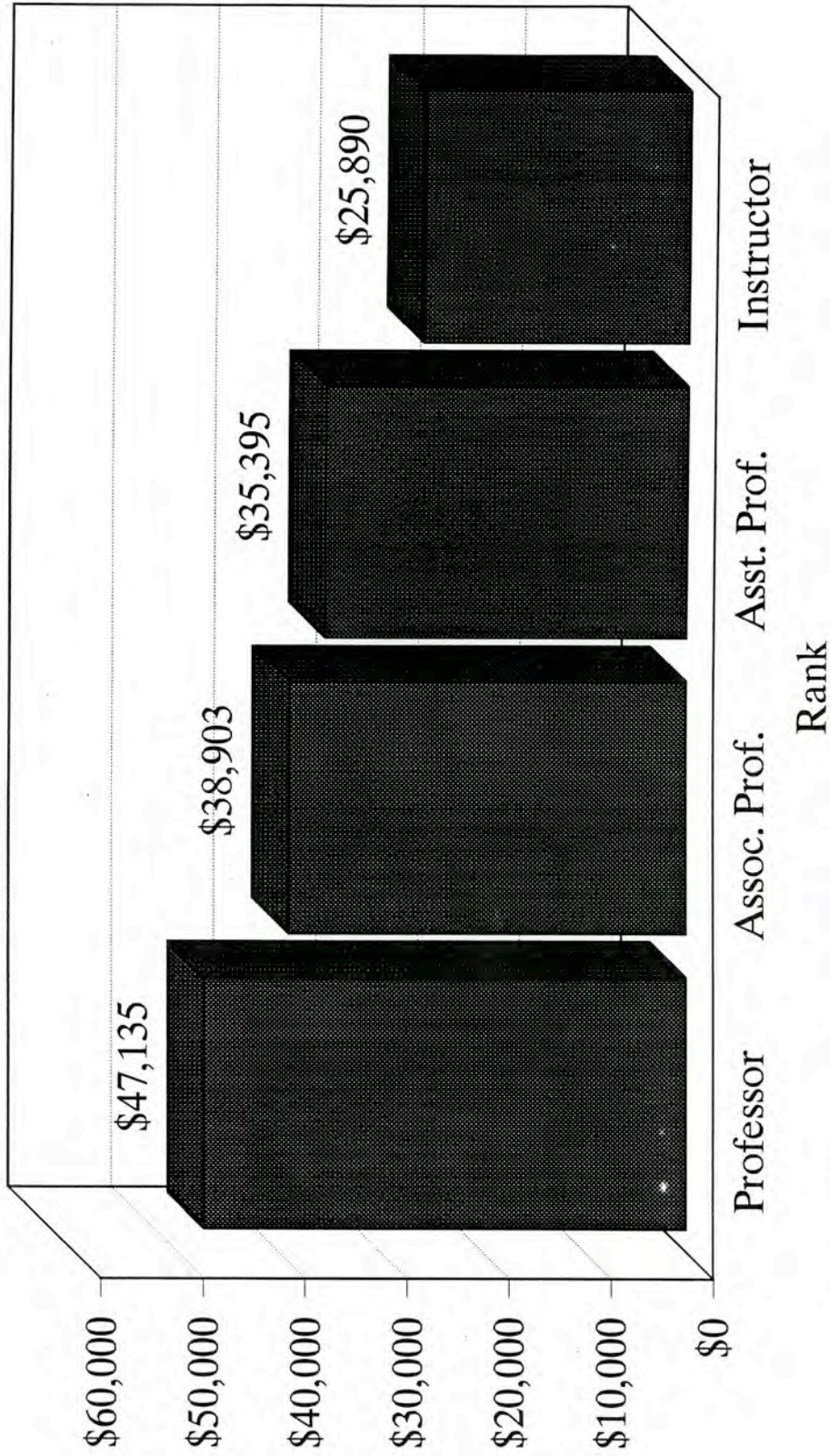

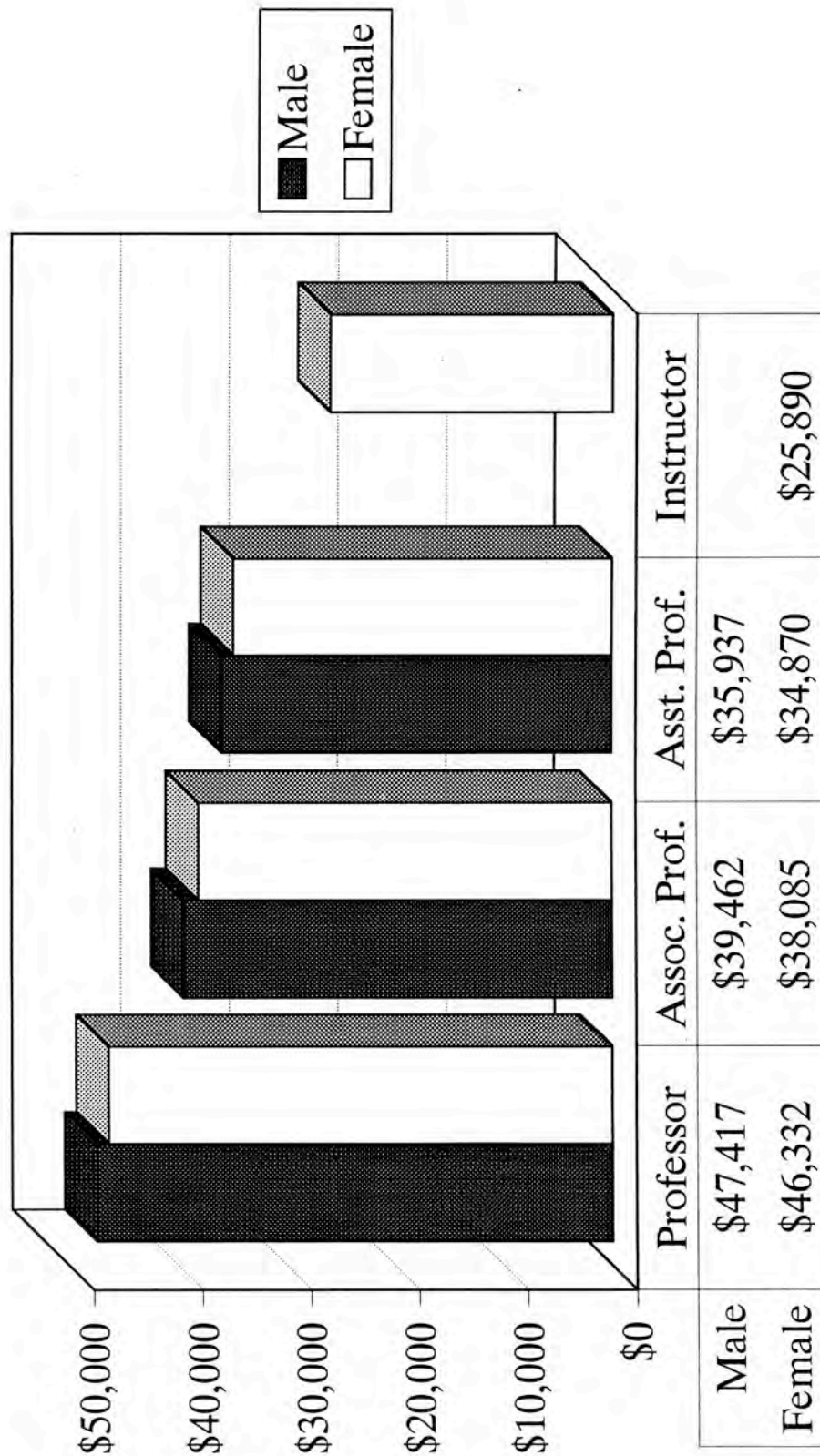

AVERAGE FULL-TIME FACULTY SALARY BY RANK & GENDER

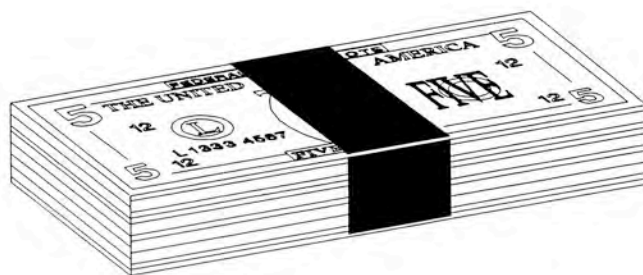

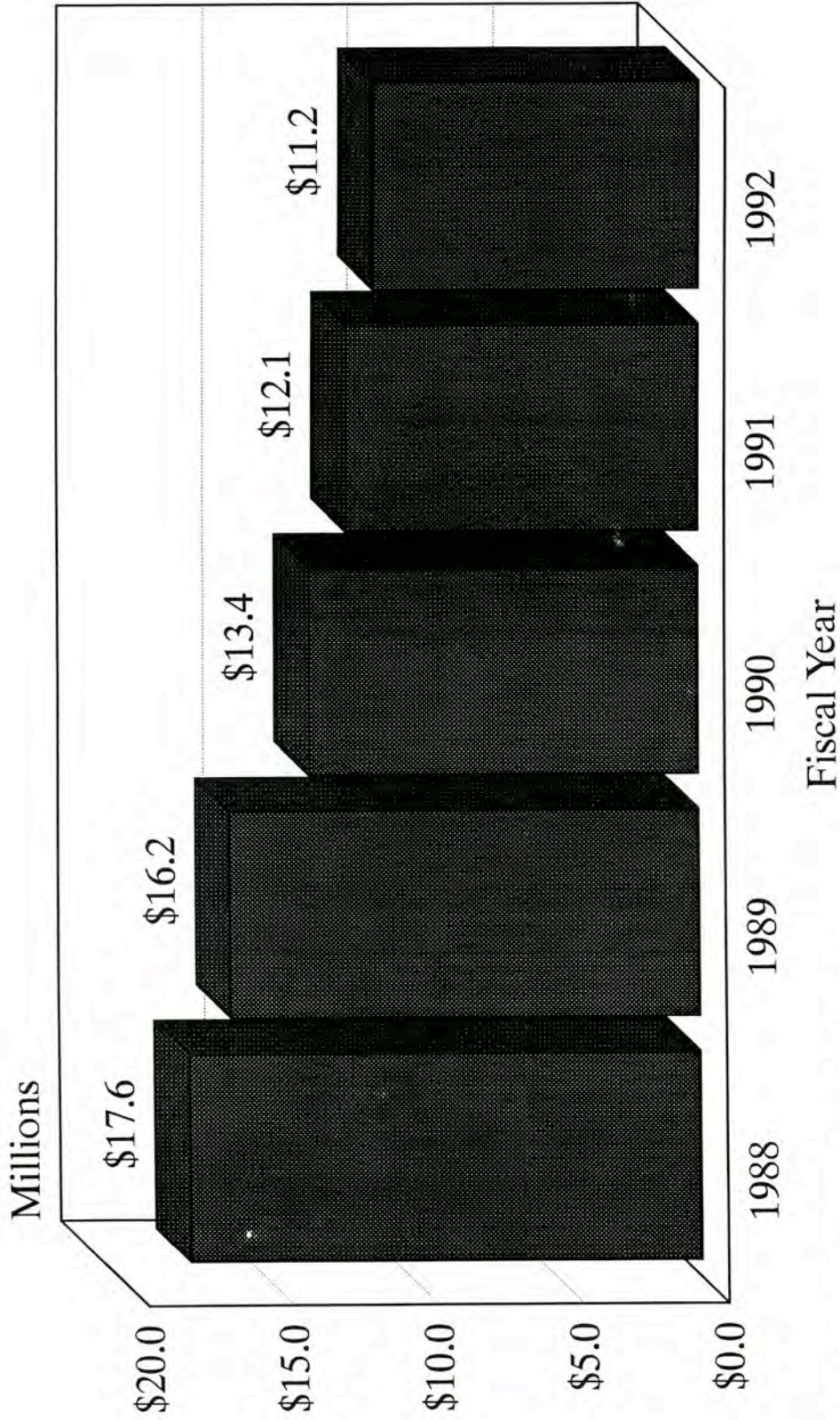

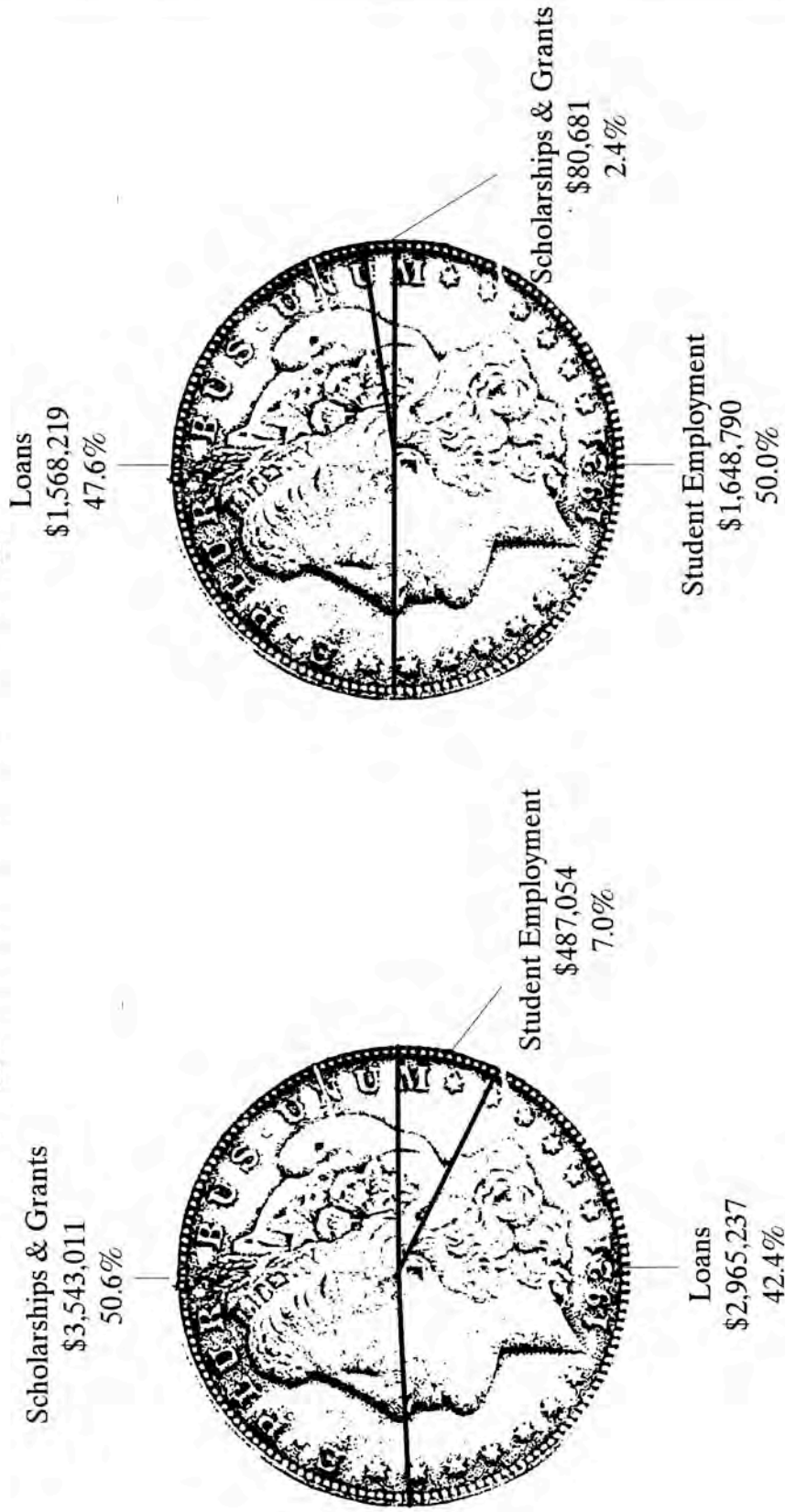

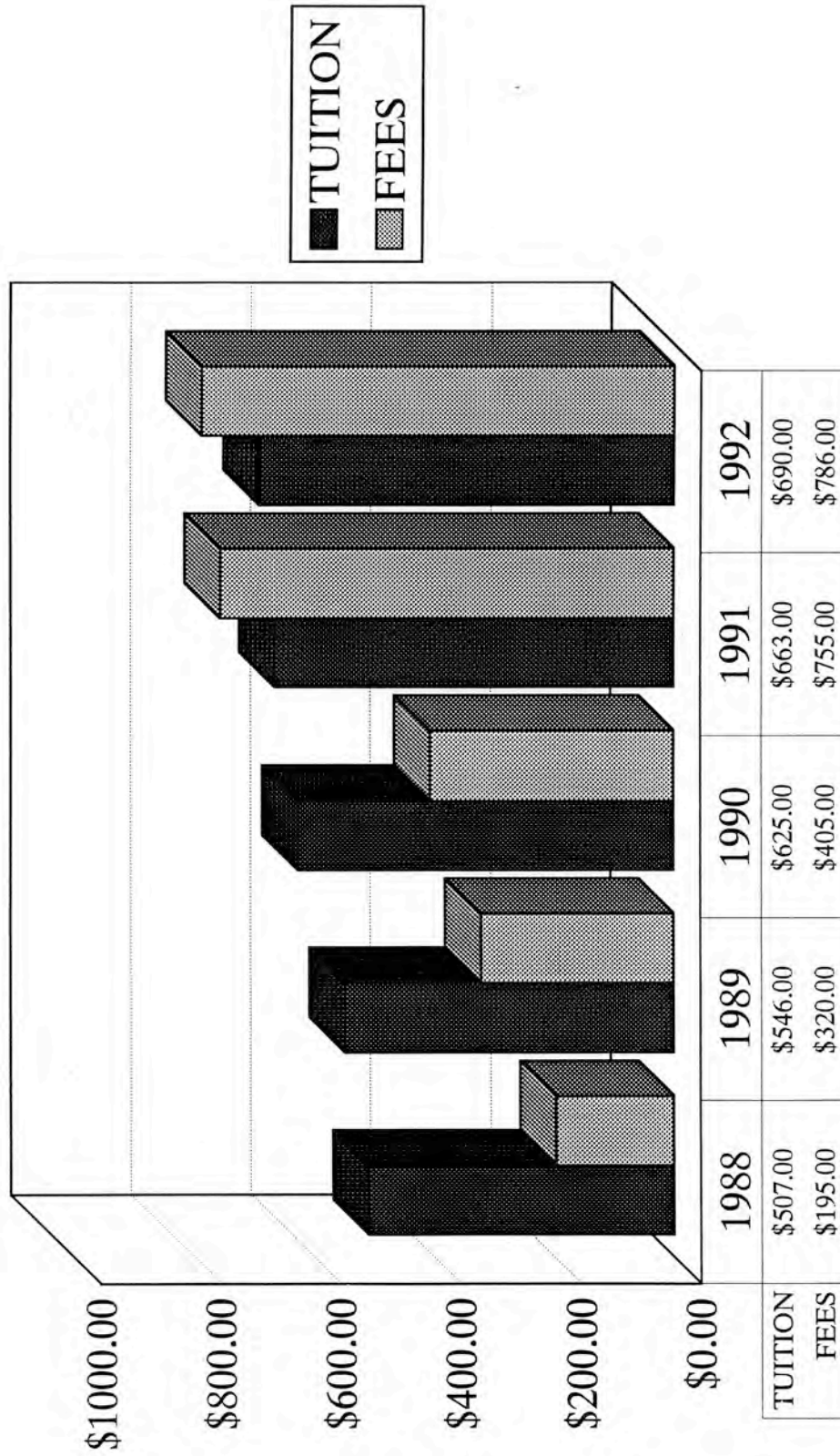

FALL 1988 - FALL 1992

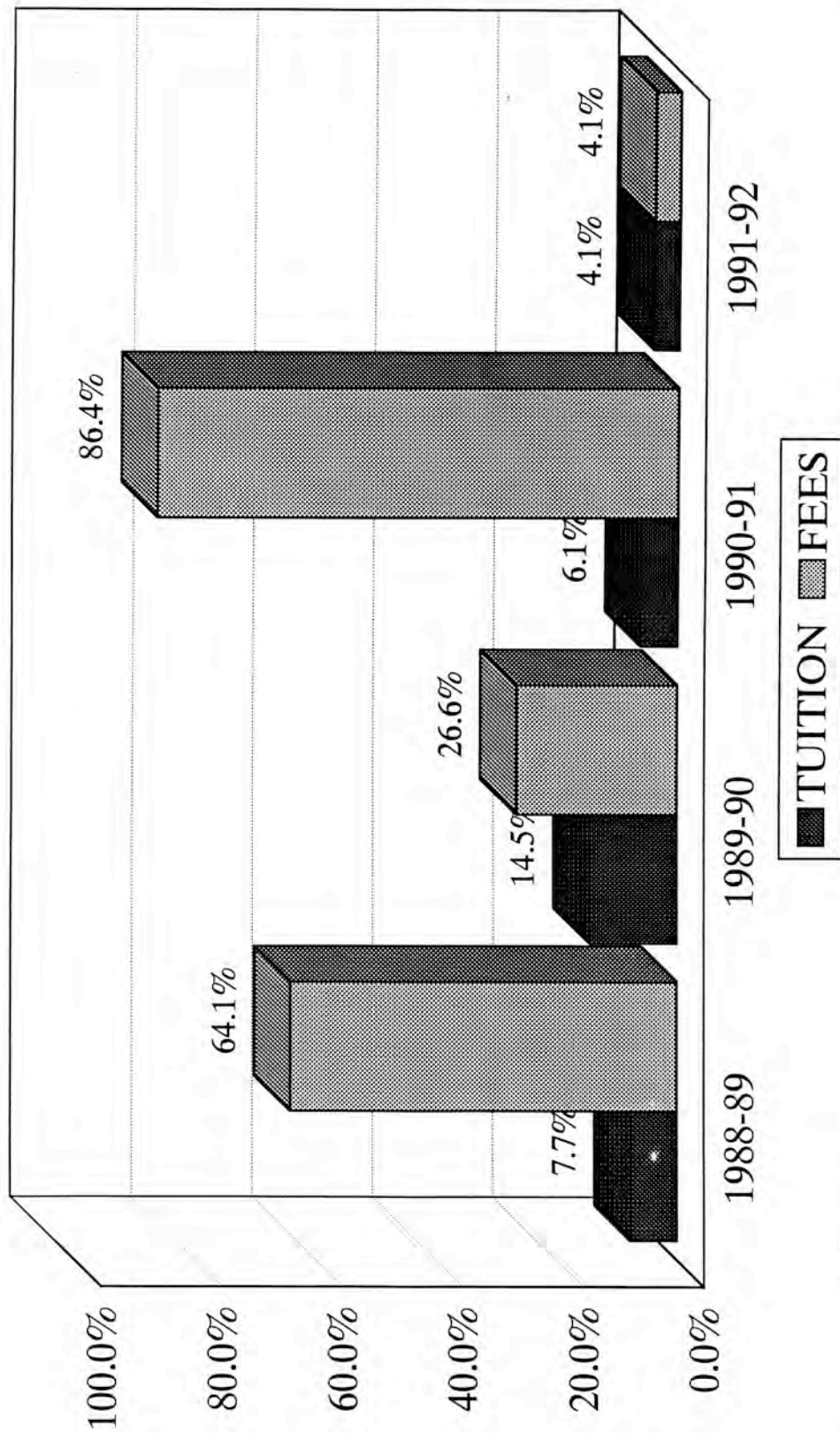

G L O S S A R Y

Academic Year

Fall and Spring semesters, for example: AY 91-92 refers to academic year 1991 (Fall) - 1992 (Spring).

Accepted

Admitted by the institution.

Annual Full-Time Equivalent (FTE) Enrollment

The average of the fall and spring FTE enrollments for an academic year.

C.A.G.S.

Certificate of Advanced Graduate Study.

Census Date

Date on which official enrollment data are extracted from the student information system. This generally occurs two weeks beyond the last add/drop day.

Class

Alumni who graduated in a fiscal year, between July 1 in one year and June 30 in the next year. For example, a student graduating between July 1, 1990 and June 30, 1991 belongs to the class of '91.

Cohort

All students who entered institution at same time; usually designated by matriculation year.

Cumulative GPA

The grade point average calculated on all work completed at BSC.

Enrolled

Registered in coursework at time of semester census date.

First-Time Freshmen

Freshmen attending any college for the first time, including those with Advanced Placement credit, with fewer than 9 semester hours of transfer credit and those who have earned college credits prior to high school graduation and/or during summer session between high school and college matriculation.

Fiscal Year

Funding year that includes July 1 through June 30, for example: FY 1992 refers to the fiscal year from July 1,1991 through June 30,1992.

Foreign

Not a U.S. citizen, permanent resident, or refugee.

Freshman

Enrolled student with less than 24 accumulated credit hours.

Full-time Equivalent (FTE) Employee

Sum of the number of full-time employees (headcount) and the FTE of part-time employees; Part-time FTE determined by dividing the sum of part-time employees weekly work hours by 37.5.

Full-time Equivalent (FTE) Faculty

Sum of the number of full-time faculty (headcount) and the FTE of part-time faculty; Part-time faculty FTE determined by dividing the sum of course credit hours taught by 15.

Full-Time Equivalent (FTE) Student Enrollment

Full-time equivalent student enrollment is based on a formula by converting student credit hours as follows: lower division (semester credit hours/15; annual credit hours/30), upper division (semester credit hours/15; annual credit hours/30), graduate (semester credit hours/12; annual credit hours/24).

Full-Time Student

Undergraduates:

Student registered for 12 or more credit hours.

Graduates:

Students registered for 9 or more credit hours.

Headcount Enrollment

Number of students registered at census date, regardless of student's course/credit load.

Junior

Enrolled student with accumulated credit hours: 54.0 - 83.5.

Lower Division

Courses numbered 000 to 299.

Non-Resident

Paying out-of-state tuition.

Part-Time Student

Undergraduates:

Student registered for fewer than 12 credit hours.

Graduates:

Student registered for fewer than 9 credit hours.

Program Level

Level of instruction based upon degree objective (i.e., undergraduate or graduate).

Residency

In-state or out-of-state student, determined for tuition purposes.

Retention Rate

Percent of students enrolled or graduated from fall semester to fall semester; usually reported by entering freshman cohort.

SAT Score

Scholastic Aptitude Test score.

Senior

Enrolled student with accumulated credit hours greater than or equal to 84.

Sophomore

Enrolled student with accumulated credit hours: 24.0 - 53.5.

Student Credit Hours

Credit value of course multiplied by enrollment as of the semester census date.

Student Level

Indication of students' progress toward a degree: freshman, sophomore, junior, senior, unclassified.

Tenured

Tenure status as of fall census date.

Terminal Degree

Generally defined as the doctoral or first-professional degree, and the following Master's level degrees: MFA, MBA (if awarded prior to 1988).

Transfer Student

Attended a higher education institution elsewhere (earned 9 or more credits). Status determined by admissions entrance code.

Unclassified

Non-degree seeking student; cannot be classified into a student level because not pursuing a degree.

Undeclared

Student has not specified a major program or has specified one not offered by BSC.

Upper Division

Courses numbered 300 to 499.
