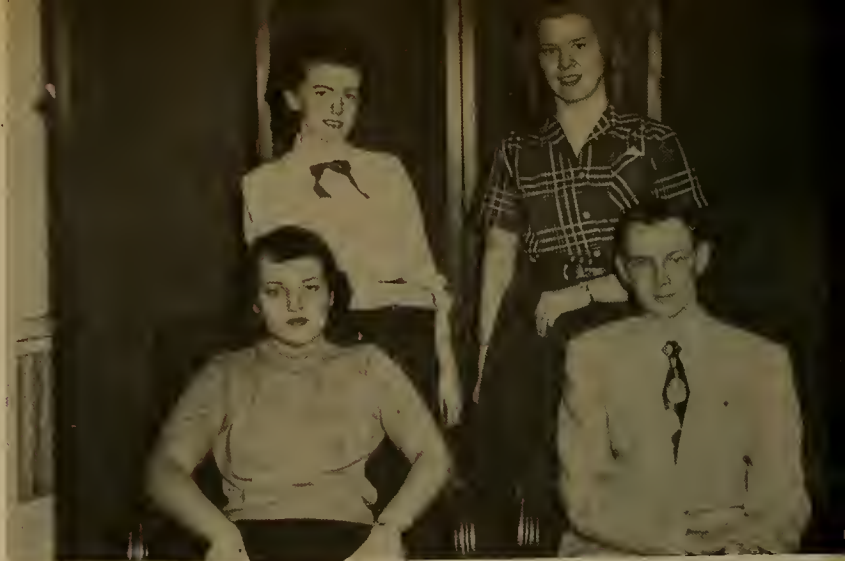

The 1954 season will be captained by Joseph Bruno and another successful season is in the making.

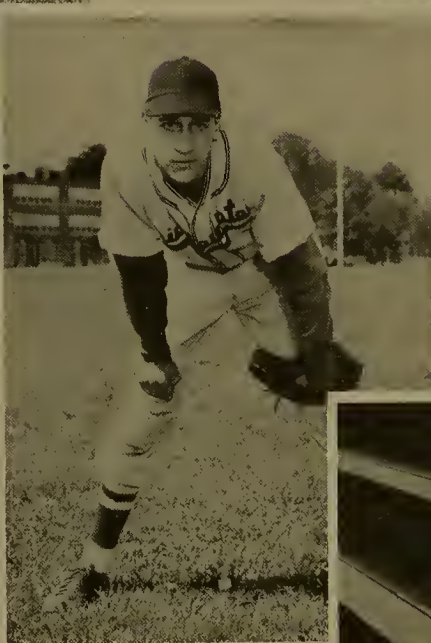
