## Broadcast Yourself on YouTube

### What you can do:

Create a short video that is available on the web.

### Overview

Mini lectures, announcements, interviews, dramatic readings . . . add a visual dimension to all of these by recording a video for yourself! You can easily and quickly broadcast yourself using a YouTube Channel. These broadcasts can be linked from, or embedded in, your course space.



### Steps

1. Create a You Tube account.
2. Create a You Tube Channel.
3. Record a video.
4. Publish a video.
5. Link to or embed a video.




## Broadcast Yourself on YouTube

### Step 1: Create a YouTube Account

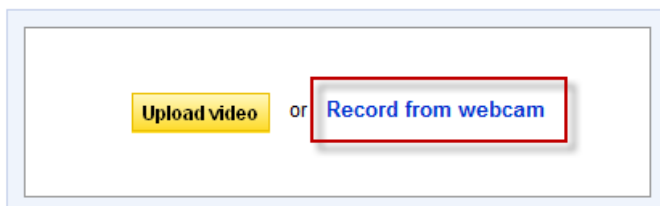
	Go to: <a href="http://www.youtube.com">http://www.youtube.com</a> and click on the <b>Create Account</b> link at the top right of the screen.
	Complete the <i>Account Creation</i> form, clicking the <b>I accept</b> button when done.
	If you already have a Google account, add your username email and password to the Google Login and click the <b>Sign in</b> button.  <b>OR</b>  If you do not already have a Google account, complete the form to create one and click the <b>Create New Account and Finish</b> button.
	If you created a new account, you will see the message to the left and will need to go to your email account to complete the set up process.
	Sign into YouTube.

### Step 2: Create a Video

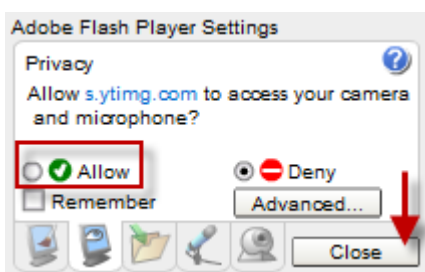
	Plug the web cam into a USB port on your computer.
	Select the <b>Upload</b> link at the top of the screen.

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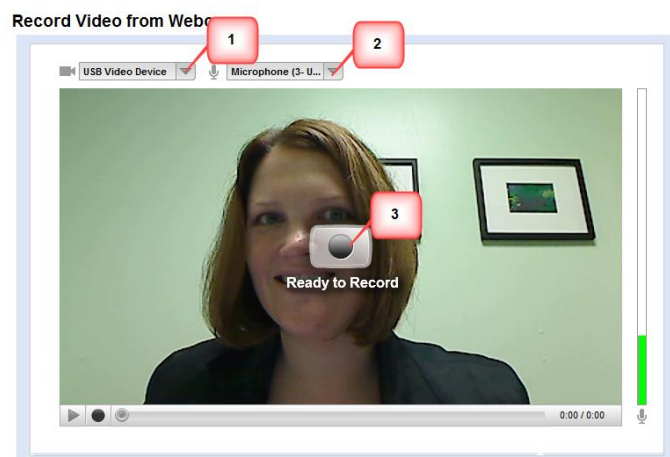
### Video File Upload



Click the **Record from webcam** link under *Video File Upload*.



If you are prompted to set *Adobe Flash Player Settings*, select the **Allow** option, then click the **Close** button.



You should see your image on the screen.

If you need to change the web camera source, use the (1) drop-down menu next to the video icon to select the web cam.

If you need to change the audio source, use the (2) drop-down menu next to the microphone icon to select the web cam .

When you are ready to begin recording, press the **Ready to Record** button (3).



When you are done recording, click the red box at the bottom of the video screen.


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	<p>Click the <b>Preview</b> (1) button to see the video recording.</p> <p>Click the <b>Publish</b> button (2) to publish the video to the web.</p> <p>Click the <b>Re-record</b> button (3) to record the video again.</p>
	<p>Once the video has been published, you will be prompted to add video information that will display with the video and control access to the video.</p> <p>Complete the <i>Video Information</i>, <i>Video Thumbnail</i>, <i>Broadcasting &amp; Sharing Options</i> and <i>Date &amp; Map</i> sections as desired.</p> <p>Click the <b>Save Changes</b> button (bottom left) when you are done.</p>
	<p>You will see a confirmation when video details have been uploaded.</p> <p>Click the <b>View on video page &gt;&gt;</b> link.</p>
	<p>Here you can see your video on the YouTube site.</p>

### How to Delete a Video from Your YouTube Channel




	<p>Click on your username in top right of screen.</p>
	<p>Select "My Videos"</p>

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



### Step 3: Share the video



Videos can be shared in three ways: 1) share the URL that will bring viewers directly to the video; 2) share your YouTube Channel so viewers can see all videos by you; or 3) embed a video in your course space

Share the URL	
 <p><a href="http://www.youtube.com/watch?v=gSW62rAnQUg">http://www.youtube.com/watch?v=gSW62rAnQUg</a></p>	<p>While your video is displaying, copy the URL from the browser window.</p>
Share your YouTube Channel	
	<p>Direct viewers to: <a href="http://www.youtube.com/user/SuperTechteach">http://www.youtube.com/user/SuperTechteach</a></p>
Embed your video in your course space	
	<p>Embed your video on another web page (in your course space for example).</p> <p>Click the <b>Embed</b> button under the video.</p>
 <p>After making your selection, copy and paste the embed code above. The code changes based on your selection.</p>	<p>Select the displayed code and copy it.</p> <p><b>Hint:</b> Click once in the box, press the <b>CTRL</b> key + the <b>A</b> key and then press <b>CTRL</b> key + the <b>C</b> key.</p>

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	<p>In your course space, while in the <i>Build</i> tab, navigate to the section of your course (home page, folder, learning module) in which you wish to embed the video.</p> <p>Click the <b>Add File</b> button.</p>
	<p>Select the <b>Create File</b> option.</p>
<p>* Title: <input type="text" value="Sample Video"/></p>	<p>In the <i>Title</i> field, add a title for the page.</p>
<p>* Content:</p> 	<p>In the <i>Content</i> field, make sure your toolbar is displaying.</p> <p>If the toolbar is not displaying:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Make sure you are using <a href="#">Firefox</a> as your browser.</li> <li>• Click the <b>Enable HTML Creator</b> button at the top right of the <i>Content</i> field.</li> </ul>
<p>* Content:</p> 	<p>Place your cursor in the desired location within the <i>Content</i> field.</p> <p>Click the <b>Source View</b> tab at the bottom of the <i>Content</i> field.</p> <p>Paste the code you copied in step 1. To paste:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Windows: <b>CTRL + V</b> or right-click &amp; choose <b>Paste</b></li> <li>• Mac: <b>APPLE + V</b> or click, hold &amp; choose <b>Paste</b></li> </ul>

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<p>*Content:</p> 	<p>Click on the <b>WYSIWYG</b> (What You See Is What You Get) tab at the bottom of the <i>Content</i> field.</p>
	<p>You will see a placeholder indicating where the embedded content will appear on your page.</p> <p>You can move your cursor before or after the placeholder to add other content to the page.</p> <p>Click the <b>Save</b> button when you are done.</p>
